





Colonel Dan Reilly serves as director of the Directorates of Logistics (DOL) Enterprise realignment initiative. In that position, he leads the realignment of maintenance, supply, ammunition, transportation, food service, and other support service functions from the U.S. Army Installation Management Command (IMCOM) to ASC. The functions transferring to ASC encompass 53 maintenance facilities and 184 supply activities located at 77 domestic and overseas locations. These installation DOLs are responsible for a budget of over \$1 billion and a workforce of 5,400 civilians and 18,000 contractor employees.
