Economic Engine

- Largest employer in region
 - Continued Employment growth
 - ~300 FTE annually through 2015 adding ~ 1500 jobs
 - Does not include contractors and services
- >\$2B in contracts in 2009
- >\$600M in Maryland contracts in 2009
- >\$55M in local contracts in 2009
- \$2B in construction
 - Primary subcontractors Maryland, local
 - USAMRIID Example: >\$260M in local subcontracts + purchases


Department of Business & Economic Development

- >16,500 jobs created in region to sustain installation

Nallin Farm Gate

• Provide an overview of the Nallin Farm Gate Project





Purpose of the Project

- To replace non-compliant, older gate with limited throughput
- To reduce traffic congestion around Fort Detrick
- To improve security and queuing of vehicles visiting Fort Detrick
- To support the growth of multiple missions at Fort Detrick

Considerations

- Expected business growth
- Expected employee growth
- Safety considerations
- Preservation/enhancement of historical areas
- Extensive Corps of Engineers Traffic Study
- Lack of traffic queuing on 7th Street/Old Farm Gates
- Functions:
 - ID check
 - Visitor processing
 - Vehicle inspections
 - Vehicle registration
 - (Future) News Media Parking- rather than blocking 7th St.
- Complements Monacacy Blvd Exchange Plan



Where is it?





Proposed Features

- Two inbound lanes from Opossumtown Pike
- Three inbound checkpoint lanes diverging from and merging back to Two lanes
- Two outbound lanes widen to three lanes at intersection with Opossumtown Pike
- Guard islands with tandem processing capabilities
- Guardhouse located after last turnaround
- Visitor center
- New traffic signal




Proposed Design

Nallin Farm Gate


- Nallin Farm Gate will reduce traffic impact on all three sides of Fort Detrick
