Fort Detrick, Maryland

- Joint-Interagency, National Asset
- Top 1% in nation for safety
- Area's largest employer and consumer
- >\$2 billion-plus in construction
- Partner and major contributor throughout many communities
- Highly skilled workforce
- Culture of Sustainability



Economic Engine

- Largest employer in region
 - Continued Employment growth
 - − ~300 FTE annually through 2015 adding ~ 1500 jobs
 - Does not include contractors and services
- >\$2B in contracts in 2009
- ~\$1.7B economic impact (2008)
- >\$652M in Maryland contracts in 2009
- >\$55M in local contracts in 2009
- ~\$2B in construction
 - Primary subcontractors Maryland, local
 - USAMRIID Example: >\$260M in local subcontracts + purchases
- >16,500 jobs created in region to sustain installation
 - Expected to increase through 2015






Conclusion
