SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum # 08, Improper Personal Relationships at USASMA

1. Reference: AR 600-20, Army Command Policy, Rapid Action Revision (RAR), dated 11 Feb 09.
2. Purpose: To outline the Commandant's policy on Improper Relationships at USASMA.
3. Student-Faculty relationships at USASMA: The foundation of effective training at USASMA rests on the integrity and fairness of the faculty and staff. Concerns about favoritism detract from the focus on training and education and compromise the quality of instruction. Personal relationships between a faculty or staff member and students are prohibited, regardless of whether or not faculty or staff member is directly responsible for the student. In addition, faculty and staff members should take care to avoid even the appearance of a personal relationship of any kind.
4. AR 600-20 establishes Army policy regarding relationships between soldiers of different ranks and further defines inappropriate relationships which are prohibited as those that:
 - a. Compromise, or appear to compromise, the integrity of supervisory authority or the chain of command.
 - b. Cause actual or perceived partiality or unfairness.
 - c. Involve, or appear to involve, the improper use of rank or position for personal gain.
 - d. Are, or are perceived to be, exploitative or coercive in nature.
 - e. Create an actual or clearly predictable adverse impact on discipline, authority, morale, or the ability of the command to accomplish its mission.
3. Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action under the Uniform Code of Military Justice or applicable civilian service regulations.
