DATA REQUIRED BY THE 1974 PRIVACY ACT Personal Information Concerning Next-of-Kin (NOK)

1. **AUTHORITY:** 10 USC, 44 USC

2. **PRINCIPAL PURPOSE:** Department of Defense agencies will use the personal information pertaining to you and your NOK to process you and your personal effects in case of injury or death.

3. **VOLUNTARY DISCLOSURE:** Disclosure of information is voluntary. Disclosure enables government agencies (i.e., medical or mortuary services and personal affairs) to facilitate processing procedures and ensure your return to your country.

GROUND RULES

1. Media personnel will not knowingly attempt to report on, photograph or relay known classified information which includes, but is not limited to, location names and coordinates.
2. All media products filed through U.S. military facilities will be subject to security review.
3. Military facilities and equipment will not be used to file media products that adversely affect personnel or operational security.
4. Media personnel accompanying units in the field will abide by the orders of those personnel responsible for their safety and security.
5. Military personnel will not intervene on behalf of any media personnel in disputes with ROK forces or government.
6. Disagreements between media and C/JIB Security Review personnel will be resolved, if possible, by the C/JIB director. Disagreements between the C/JIB director and disagreement between the C/JIB director and media personnel will be resolved by the CFC PAO.

Violations of the above six ground rules can result in suspension of credentials and expulsion from the theater of operations.
