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Menu and Restaurant Guide

Places to have a meal

A Gasthaus, Gasthof or Gaststätte is a place with a cozy, family type atmosphere where you'll find good traditional German food. You don't have to eat in this type of place; you can just go in for a beer, coke, or any other drink and just relax for a while. Many of them have a every nice Biergarten to sit outside in the summer.

A restaurant is much the same as in the States. If you want a bigger or a fancy meal, this is the place to go. You will usually find a variety of German, Greek, Italian, and Chinese restaurants in every town. Restaurants are usually a little more expensive than a Gasthaus, Gaststätte.

A Café is a place where you can relax with a cup of coffee and some pastries. Of course, you will also be able to buy any other drink here, and in most cafes, you can also find a light meal.

A Bistro is in-between a café and a bar. You can enjoy a light meal or drink in a very pleasant comfortable atmosphere.

A Weinstube is a place to spend an evening with friends, enjoying a good glass of wine or other kinds of drinks, in a very cozy type atmosphere. Smaller meals are also served here.

A Bierstube is the same type of place as a Weinstube, with a big variety of beers, also offering small meals.

Some Specialty Dishes

Gulasch - beef or pork goulash

Wiener Schnitzel - boneless breaded veal cutlet, usually served with a lemon wedge.

Jägerschnitzel - pork served with mushroom gravy, can be breaded or not breaded and fried.

Cordon Bleu - breaded pork filled with ham and cheese.

Sauerbraten - oven roasted, marinated beef with gravy.

Rindsrouladen - beef rolled flank steak filled with a variety of Stuffing, usually chopped meat and pickles.

Restaurant Tips

- ... It is not uncommon for more than one party to occupy a table.
- ... High chairs might not always be available.
- ... You will usually not be seated by a hostess find your own seat.
- ... It is customary to round your money up to the next Euro for a tip when paying the bill.
- ... You will not be able to get free "tap" water at restaurants, but of course you will be able to order both carbonated and non-carbonated water for which there is a change.
- ... There is no free refill of coffee.
