
\$200 Reward For Tag






\$100 Reward For Tag




Rewards For Tags

NOAA fisheries Auke Bay Laboratory has been deploying tags on spiny dogfish since 2004. Three types of tags have been used:

\$200 Reward for pop off satellite tags. A 5inx2in pop off satellite tag is attached to the dorsal fin spine by ~ 3in of tubing.





\$100 Reward for archival tags. A ³/₄ inch long fluorescent pink tag is attached to the dorsal fin. A 1/3inx3/4in archival tag is surgically implanted inside the dogfish.

Hat reward for numerical tags. A ³/₄ inch long fluorescent yellow tag is attached to the dorsal fin.
