# Reward For Tag



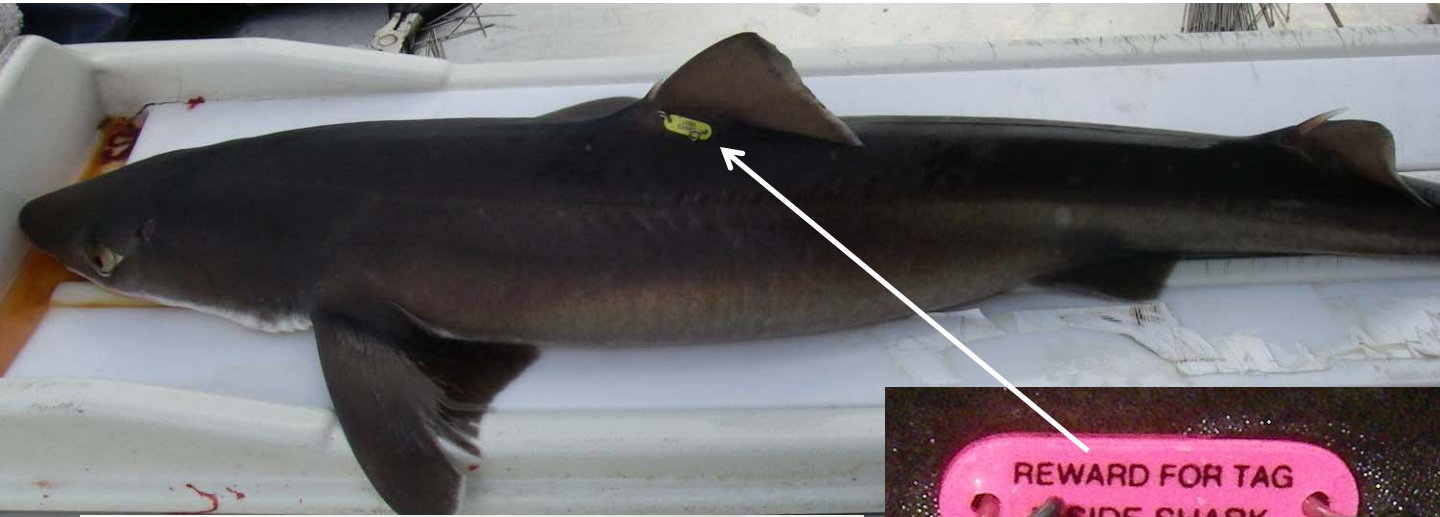

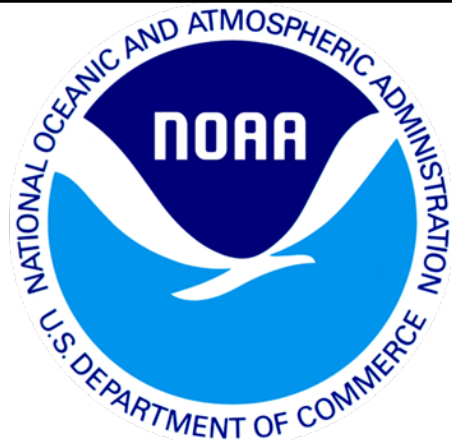
# \$100 Reward For Tag

A  $\frac{1}{3}$ in x  $\frac{3}{4}$ in archival tag is surgically implanted inside the dogfish. Data from these tags will provide information about spiny dogfish behavior and environmental conditions they experience.

# Rewards For Tags

NOAA fisheries Auke Bay Laboratory has been deploying tags on spiny dogfish since 2004. Three types of tags have been used:

**\$200 Reward for pop off satellite tags.** A 5inx2in pop off satellite tag is attached to the dorsal fin spine by ~ 3in of tubing.



**\$100 Reward for archival tags.** A  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch long fluorescent pink tag is attached to the dorsal fin. A  $\frac{1}{3}$ inx $\frac{3}{4}$ in archival tag is surgically implanted inside the dogfish.



**Hat reward for numerical tags.** A  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch long fluorescent yellow tag is attached to the dorsal fin.
