About VINCI

- VINCI is a secure, high performance computing environment where Researchers can access software, tools, and data
- Background
- Same research methods researchers typically use except they are conducted in a window to a secure server farm.
- FREE service to Researchers Not mandatory!
- Partnership between HSR&D, OI&T, and VHA ORD



What VINCLIS & IS Not

- Computing Workspace (CPU, RAM, storage)
- Facilitation of Approval for Data Access
- Materializing & Hosting Data sets
- Software (commercial and custom)

IS NOT


- Data custodian (does not own data)
- VINCI does not do data analysis for you
- Software provider outside of VINCI Workspace



VINCI Infrastructure

- 500+ TB Storage Area Network
- 70+ Servers
- Many servers are 64 core
- Windows Server 2008R2 64-bit OS
- Key servers have 2TB RAM
- SAS and Database TEMP spaces utilize FUSiON-iO solid-state memory storage
- VINCI datacenter network uses InfiniBand high-speed networks
- Processes running within the VINCI environment are not affected by VA Intranet traffic





- Behind the Gateway
- Supporting a study through the entire project including exporting study artifacts
- Access to
 - Software Tools
 - Data
 - SAS Grid
- VINCI File Transfer Utility
- H-drive / P-drive folders





Data Storage Options

■ H-Drive

- 2 GB limit
- Intended for personal file storage only
- Specifically NOT for storing study data

■ P-Drive Project Folders

- Intended for storage of shared project files
- Access is controlled and limited to study staff
- Specifically intended for study data storage

Databases

- Microsoft SQL server by default
- Can provide MySQL when necessary

- Over 50 programs available
 - Commercial, Open Source, Freeware, Shareware,
 & Government programs
 - Utility, Productivity, Programming, & Analysis
- Custom Software
 - V3NLP
 - V3NLP Interface
 - V3NLP Modules
 - V3NLP Framework

 - Annotation Admin
 - Chart Reader





Data

- Partnership with Corporate Data Warehouse (CDW) to host National-level data: 30 domains and growing
- CDW Appointment, Consult, Demographics, Health Factor, Immunization, Lab Chemistry, Mental Health, Outpatient Encounters, Outpatient Pharmacy, PCMM, and Vital Sign
- VINCI Allergies, Administrative data, ECHO, EDIS, Equipment Inventory, Fee Basis, Non-VA Meds, Prosthetics, Inpatient (PTF), Radiology, Surgery, TIU (except for 8 sites), and Vital Status
- We can help get access to other VA data sets
- Bring in your own data!



SAS Grid Computing

Dedicated 80 node grid with enormous capacity and processing power to support

large, complex processes

- 2 Dedicated SAS Engineers
 - Improving process performance
- 9 SAS modules
 - Enhanced Statistical Package; Graph;
 Econometrics and time series; Operations research; Matrix language; Quality control;
 Connect; Access; and Enterprise miner




VINCI File Transfer Utility

- Workspace utility for copying files out
- Files copied for auditing purposes
- Audit Process
 - Copies of transferred files are archived
 - Copied files are audited for for PHI, PII, and SI
- Can transfer out
 - Aggregate data
 - Documents papers, analysis, presentations
- Cannot transfer identifiable data out
 - Never any PHI, PII, or SI; even if you brought it in and own it

For setting up initial site users




Collaboration Site

- Access to study-specific DART and Software Needs Assessment applications
- Facilitate communication

 - Document repository







Software Needs Assessment


Specify who needs what software in the VINCI Workspace

 - VINCI is funded to buy software but VA process is slow

Manual process for working with VINCI Data Managers to determine data needs



Data Manager helps you understand and select from the various data sources



Data Access Request Tracker (DART)

 Application for obtaining data access approvals, not the data itself

■ Select data sources and DART tells you what documents are required

Upload documents to DART


- It distributes documents to approvers







- Data Managers for VINCI & CDW
