# Criminal Intelligence Coordinating Council (CICC)/ Global Intelligence Working Group (GIWG)

## CICC Summary for the Global Advisory Committee (GAC)

### Current CICC Products for Approval

The Criminal Intelligence Coordinating Council will be submitting two products for GAC approval: A training video for law enforcement line officers regarding the importance of privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties protections and the *Information Sharing and Criminal Intelligence Resources Guide*. A description of each product follows.

The **Importance of Privacy, Civil Rights, and Civil Liberties Protections in American Law Enforcement** training video was developed to assist law enforcement line officers in understanding their role in the protection of privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties as they perform their everyday duties. The video provides an introductory overview of privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties protections; examples of these protections; and the important function line officers have in upholding these protections.

The **Information Sharing and Criminal Intelligence Resources Guide** was developed as a central repository for the numerous intelligence-related resources available to law enforcement personnel as they develop and refine their business practices. The guide contains a listing of available products that support the implementation of the tenets of intelligence-led policing and a brief summary of what each product entails.

### Future Item for Approval

**Communications and Outreach Guidebook – Considerations for State and Urban Area Fusion Centers**, developed under the DHS/DOJ Fusion Process Technical Assistance Program and Services, is a reference tool for fusion centers to utilize when conducting communications and outreach. It has been developed to provide scalable tools, techniques, and tactics to support stakeholder outreach. As such, the principles articulated in

the guidebook can be applied to specific customer sets (e.g., state and local law enforcement) or a broader public audience.

### CICC/GIWG Mission Statement

The CICC and GIWG are charged with advising and providing recommendations to the U.S. Attorney General on issues relating to advancing the use of technology, standards, and collaboration between agencies or organizations in the area of criminal intelligence. The CICC and GIWG serve as advocates for local law enforcement agencies in their efforts to develop and share criminal intelligence for the promotion of public safety and the security of our nation.
