KEY FEATURES: *GoodTransitions* is a collaborative project dedicated to helping non-custodial parents, who may also be ex-offenders, enter into and complete a paid transitional job experience that leads to unsubsidized employment in high-demand occupations or industries, earning competitive wages, that will be retained and have the potential for career advancement. Services will include case management, administration of assessments, services that address specific barriers to employment for non-custodial parents, services that address attributes of offenders, employment skills training, job readiness, job placement, job coaching, wrap-around support services tailored to the target population, follow-up support services, and retention services for 12 months post-employment. Enhanced program components include contextualized occupational skills training concurrent to staged work experience in the Goodwill's enterprise and temporary paid work experiences with private sector employers.
