### **Adjustment to the GradeBook and MyData Portals**

Beginning January 8th at 1500 EST we will begin removing the Virtual Keyboard from the MyData and GradeBook portal log in pages. The Virtual Keyboard will be replaced with a Captcha screen that requires the users to enter a randomly generated 6 digit number each time they log in. This is a small 'security' item that will ensure that the personnel logging in are people rather than machines.


