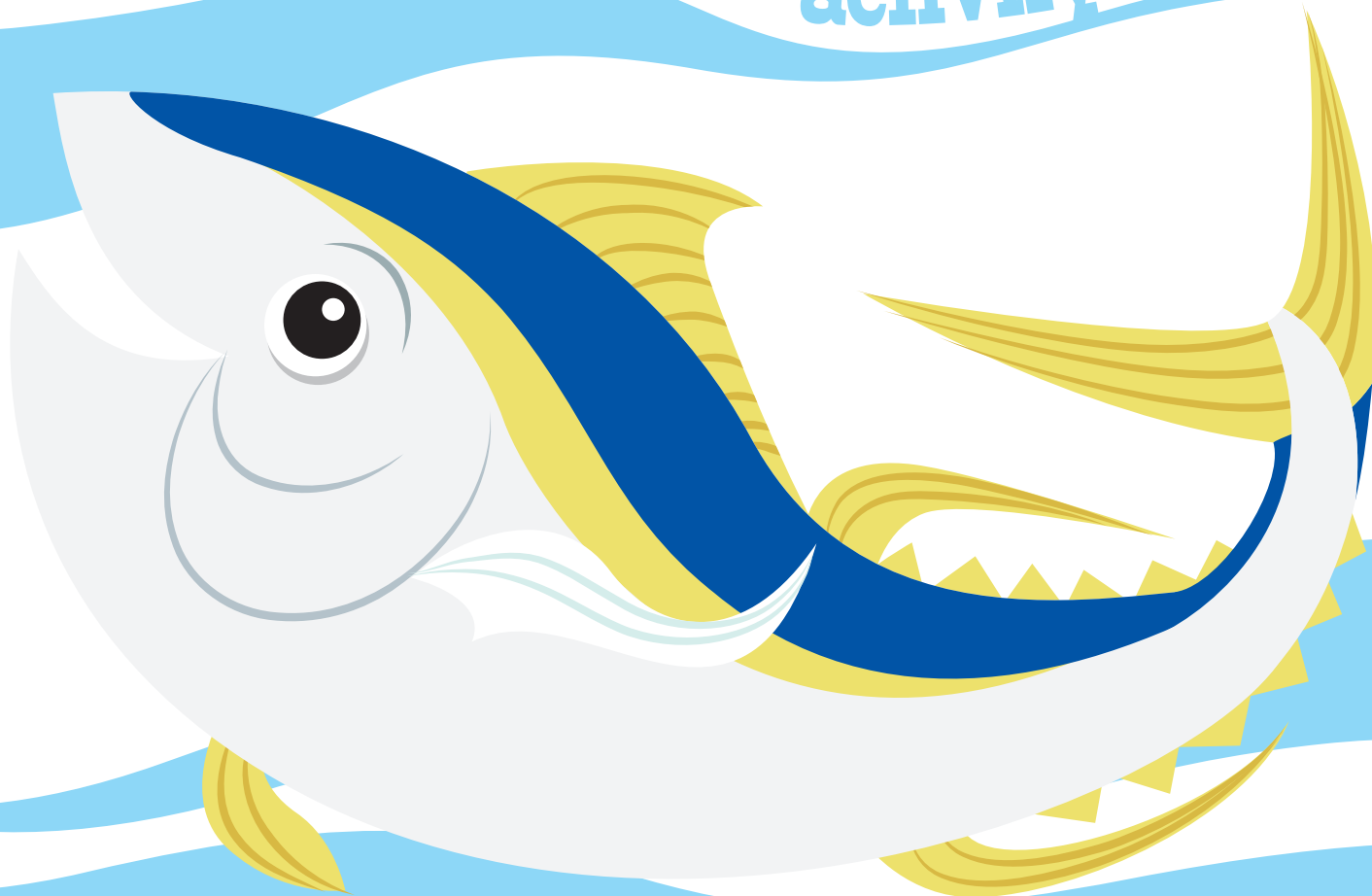

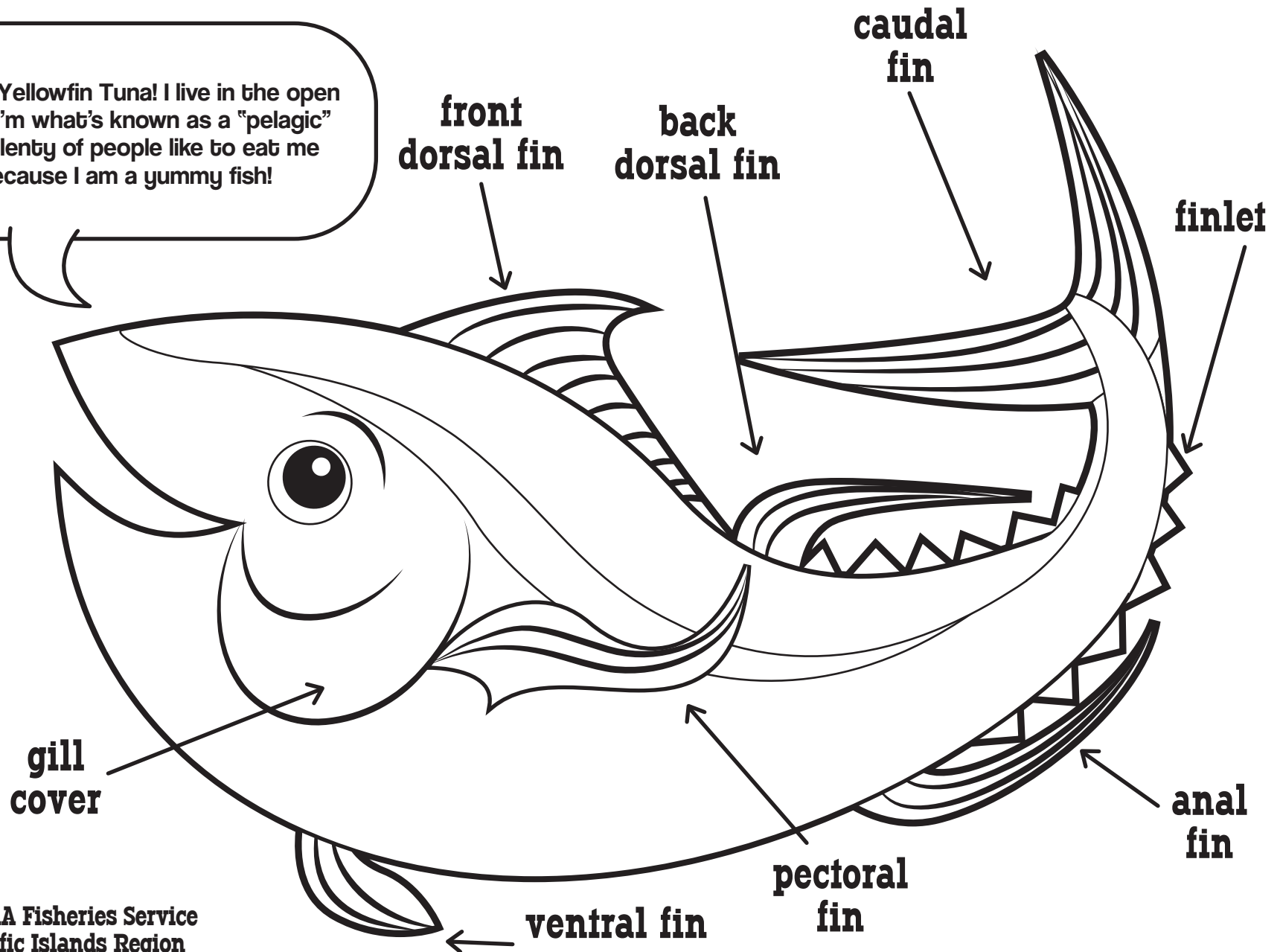

Yellowfin Tuna

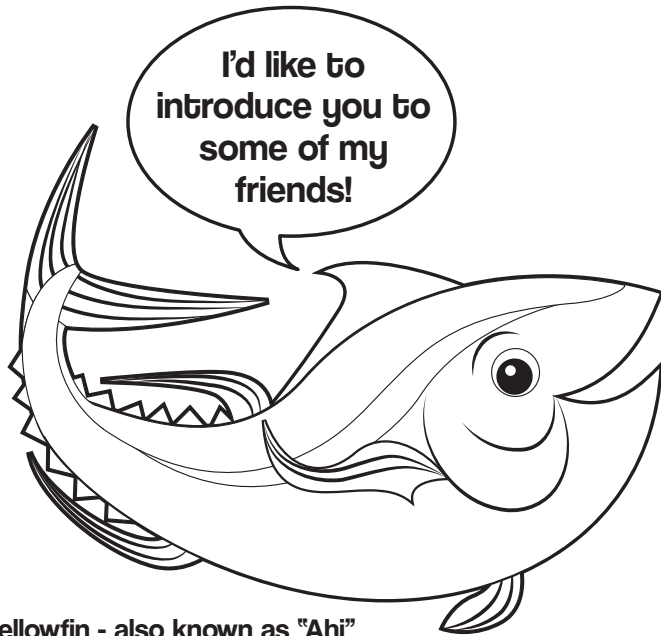

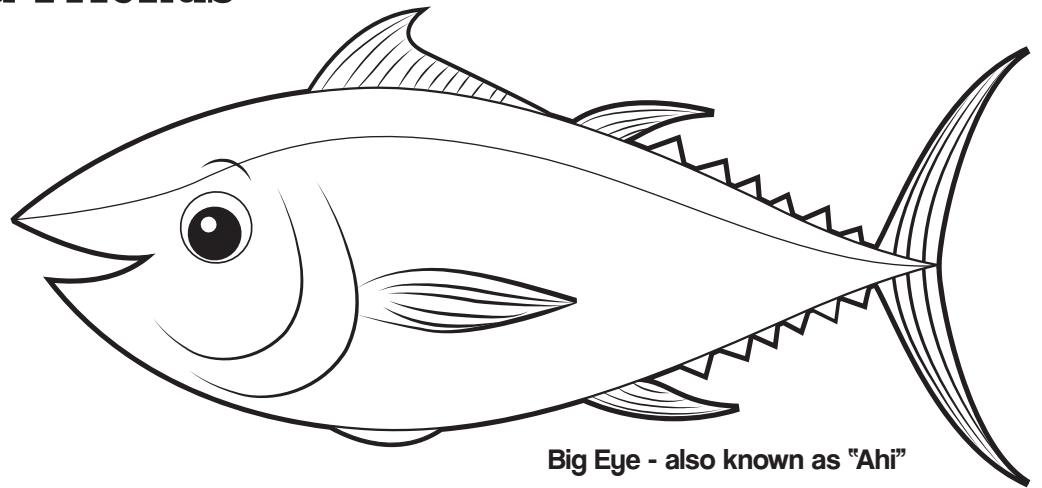

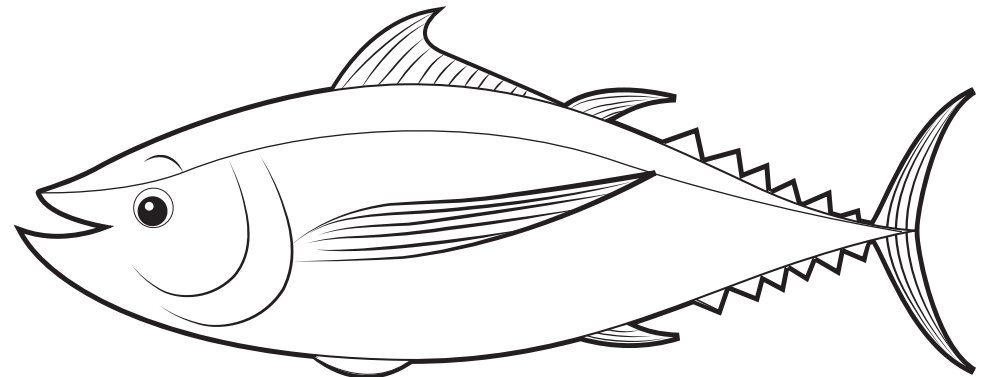
Yellowfin Tuna and Friends



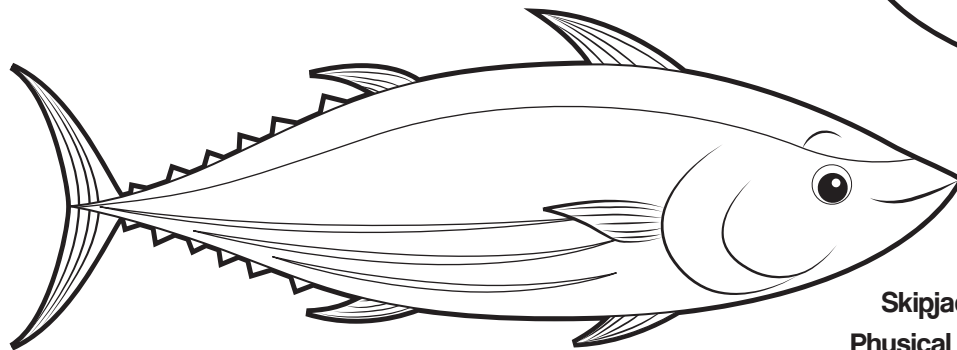
Yellowfin - also known as "Ahi"
Physical characteristics: long yellow back dorsal and anal fins and finlets



Big Eye - also known as "Ahi"
Physical characteristics: plump body and large eyes



Albacore - also known as "Tombo Ahi"
Physical Characteristics: very long pectoral fin



Skipjack - also known as "Aku"
Physical Characteristics: horizontal stripes running down its side

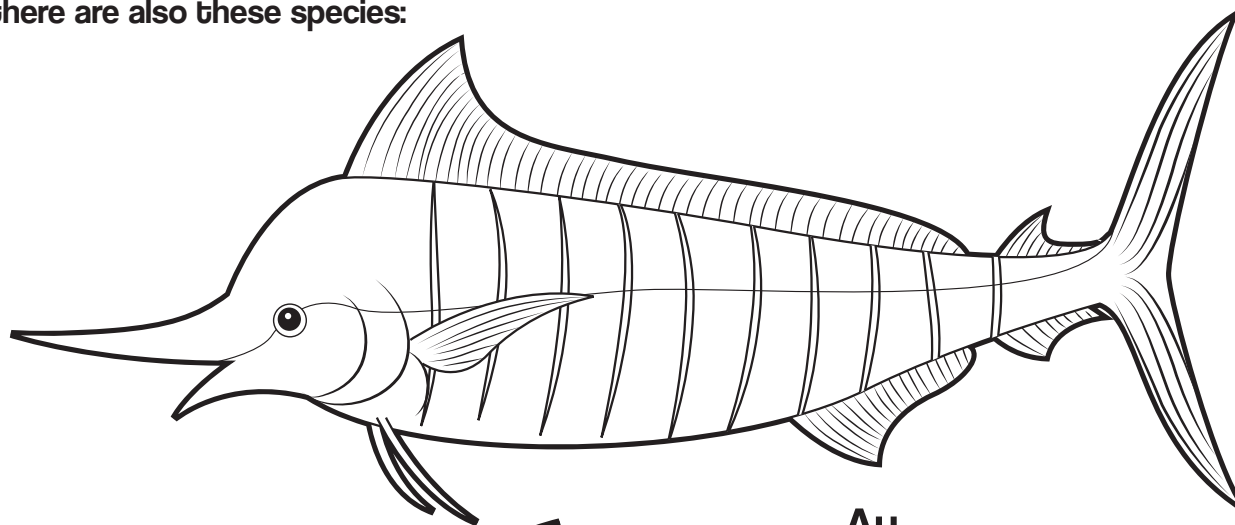

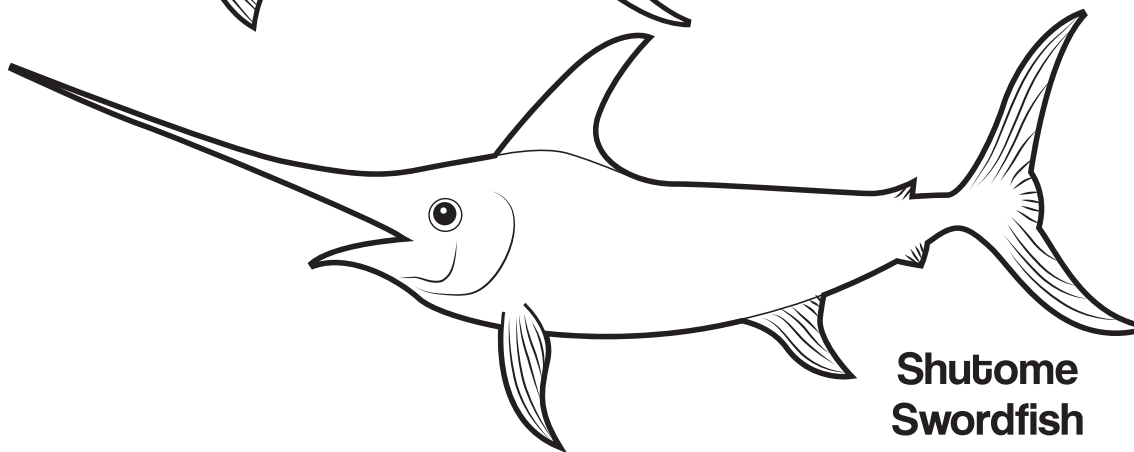

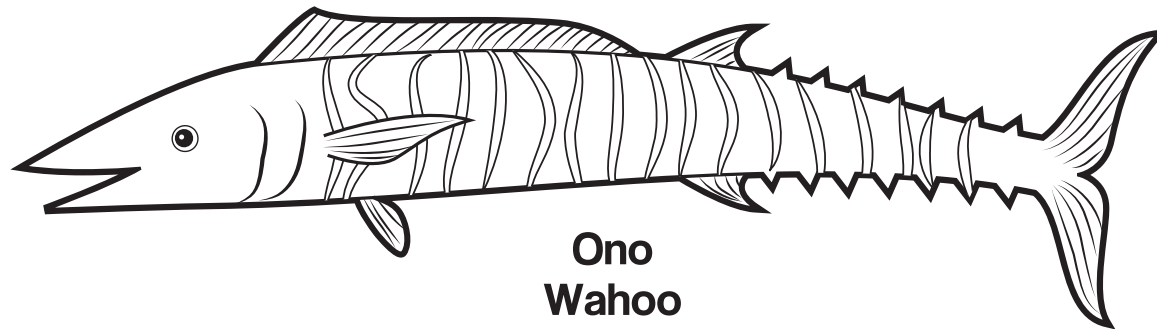

Inshore Fish

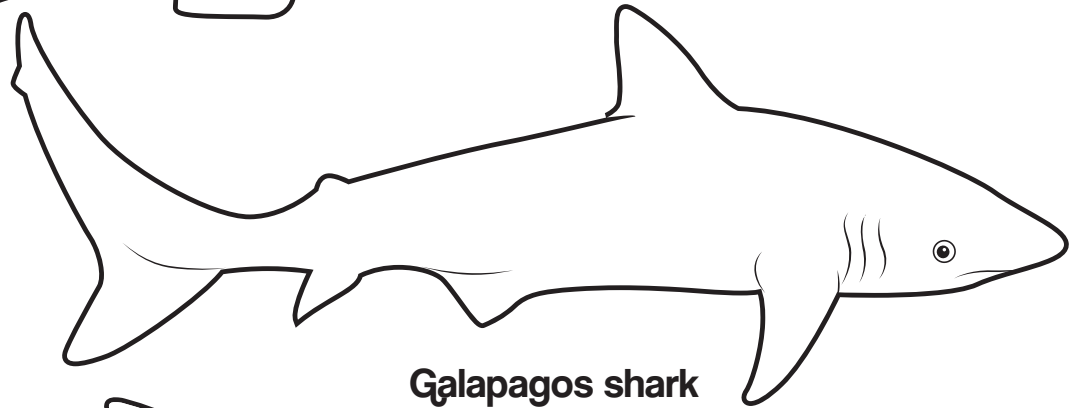
These sharks are sometimes found in coastal waters.
Sharks are a type of fish.



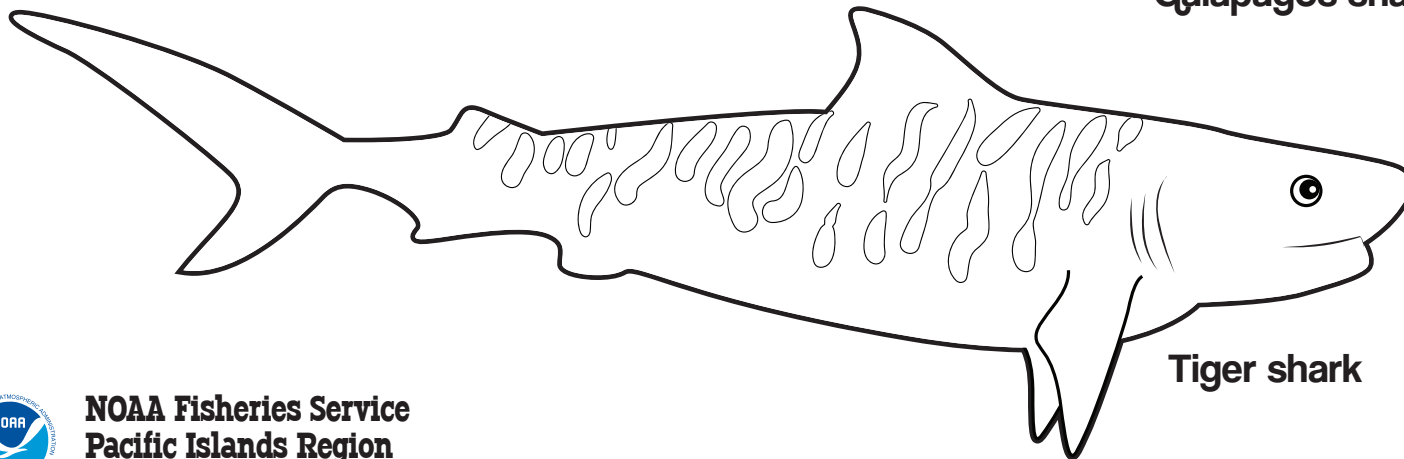
Scalloped

Tiger shark

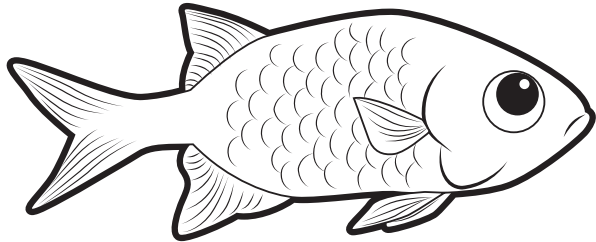

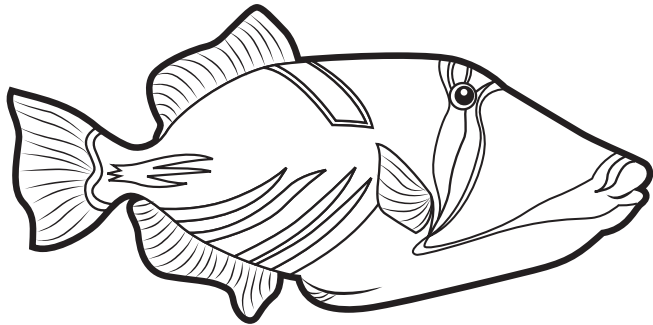

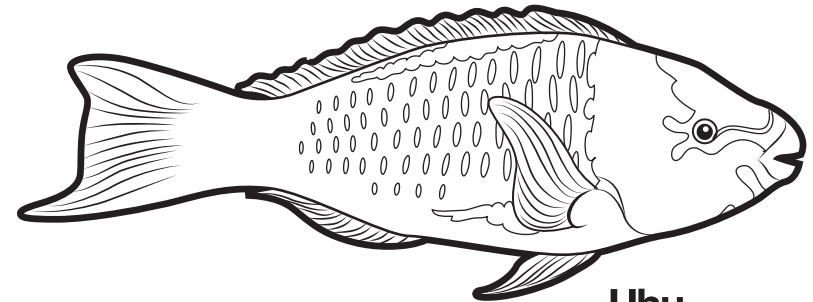

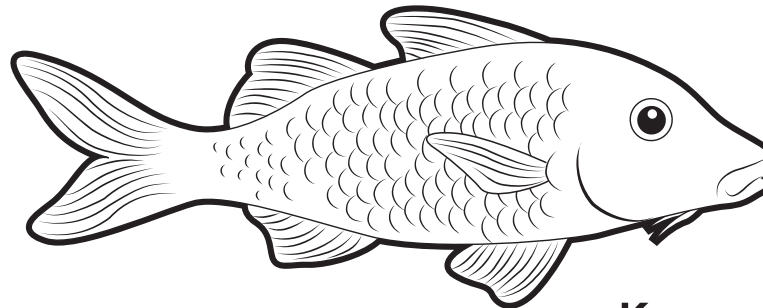

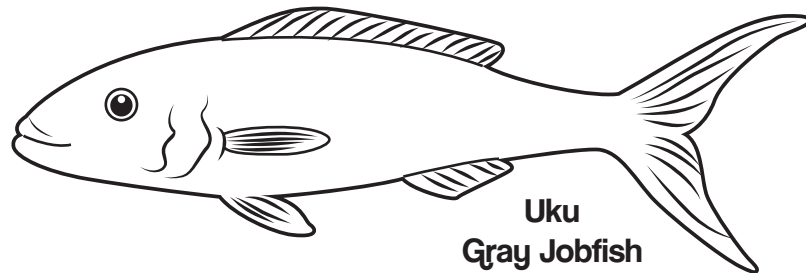

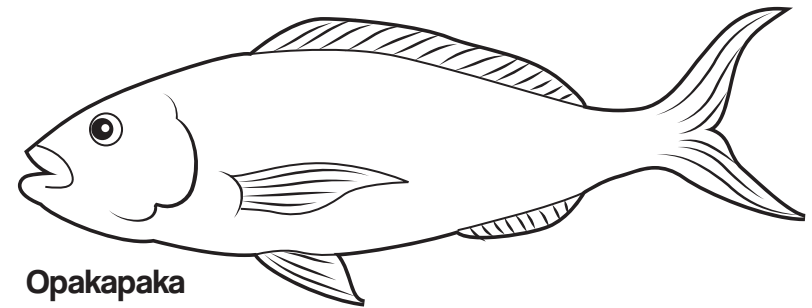

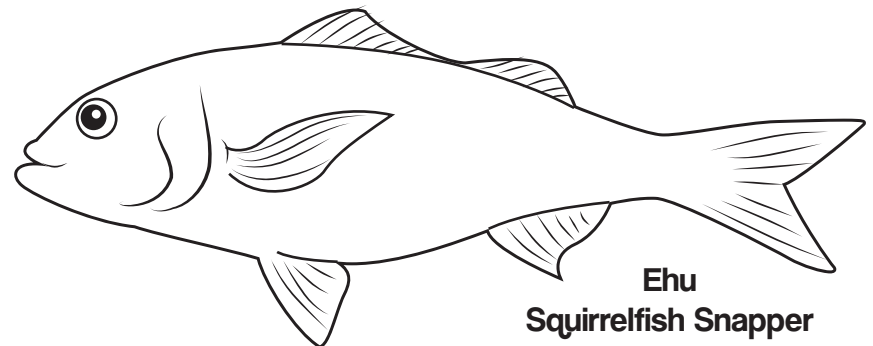
