Hawaiian spinner dolphins are protected under the Marine Mammal Protection Act.

Spinner dolphins spend their daylight hours in coastal waters, generally in calm bays. They use these areas to rest, care for their young and to avoid predators, before traveling to deeper water at night to hunt for food.
