2013 FORT McCOY SPRING TURKEY INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

<u>APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS:</u> If you were selected for a 2013 State of Wisconsin Spring Turkey Hunting Permit, you are NOT ELIGIBLE to receive a 2013 Fort McCoy Spring Turkey Hunting Permit. Individuals who are selected for a State of Wisconsin Spring Turkey Hunting Permit normally receive notification by early February. **Applicants selected for a Fort McCoy spring turkey permit will be compared with the DNR spring turkey winner list and removed from the Fort McCoy selection if selected for a state zone.**

<u>Email Address:</u> The Wildlife Program has used hunter email addresses to send hunter surveys and other information. Survey responses are a valuable tool used by the Wildlife Program to ensure we maintain healthy, viable wildlife populations and maintain a quality hunting opportunity. If you would like to participate in email surveys, please be sure to include your email address on your application form and print legibly.

New Spring Turkey Season Application and Selection Process Established

The application and selection process for all 2013 spring turkey permits has been revised in line with Department of the Army regulations. Permit selection will no longer be based on a first-come-first-serve basis. Selection will be based on a random drawing of all applications within each Category (A, B or C) with separate permit allotments established for each category (see Category definition on application information sheet).

- Category allotments are: (A) 25%, (B) 15%, and (C) 60%.
- Category allotments will be used for each hunting period and based on the applicant's first choice.
- Category A applicants will be drawn first followed by Category B and then Category C. Any Category A or B applicants not selected in the initial drawing will be included in the Category C drawing for that same period.
- Any Category A or B allotments not filled during the selection process will be available for the Category C drawing.
- All initial drawings will be conducted based on the applicant's first choice of hunting periods. Any permits remaining after the
 initial drawings will be awarded through random drawing to applicants not selected in the initial drawing and based on their
 second, third, fourth, fifth and/or sixth choice.
- Applications must be received or postmarked by the deadline date (February 11, 2013). Applications received or postmarked after February 11, 2013 will be eligible for any remaining permits on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- Applications can be mailed or dropped off at the Permit Sales Office.
- Group applications will still be accepted. Further information is listed in the application instructions.

2013 Hunting Information:

- The Youth Mentorship Program (ages 10 and 11) will be continued for the 2013 Fort McCoy Spring Turkey Hunting Seasons: Participants (youth and mentors) must follow WDNR guidelines and rules associated with the mentorship program. Youth must possess a valid Fort McCoy spring turkey permit for the hunting period they intend to participate in. Mentors must possess a valid Fort McCoy spring turkey permit for any 2013 Fort McCoy hunting period. Applicants must follow application procedures and be selected for a Fort McCoy spring turkey permit. The "Youth Mentorship" box must be marked on the application. Additional information regarding the Youth Mentorship Program will be provided to youth who have been selected for a Fort McCoy Spring quota permit. Youth applications can be submitted along with, and in addition to, any group application and does not count towards the maximum of 4 applications per envelope. Youth permit fees will be the same price as adult.
- Fort McCoy does not have a separate Youth Hunt.
- Season quotas are based on training area availability.
- <u>TIME PERIODS</u>: The statewide spring turkey season has changed to a 7-day time period running Wednesday Tuesday. Fort McCoy will continue with its 5 day seasons running Monday Friday (except the first season which is 3-days) to take into consideration of potential increase in military training on the weekends and to provide a 2-day period open for scouting with no disruption to hunters.
- WISCONSIN CONCEALED CARRY LAW: Wisconsin has passed a law allowing individuals to carry a concealed weapon with the proper permit. However, in accordance with Army Regulation 190-11 para 4-5, possession of a concealed weapon is prohibited on Fort McCoy. Carrying a concealed weapon will result in criminal prosecution, fines, revocation or suspension of hunting, fishing, trapping and firewood cutting privileges, and/or other disciplinary actions.
- WISCONSIN ACT 51: All weapons must be unloaded and cased when transported on Fort McCoy.
- <u>CONSERVATION PATRONS LICENSES</u>: Hunters that typically purchase a Conservation Patrons License should wait until
 notification is received from the Permit Sales Office before purchasing a license. This will allow time to update the WI DNR
 database so that a Spring Turkey carcass tag can be issued if selected. The ALIS vendor cannot issue a carcass tag to
 Conservation Patrons after the license is purchased

2013 SPRING TURKEY APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION PERIOD: Application Deadline is February 11, 2013

Applications may be mailed or hand delivered to the Permit Sales Office (Bldg 2168). Applications must be received or postmarked by the deadline date. Applications received or postmarked after February 11, 2013 will be eligible for any remaining permits on a first-come-first-serve basis. **Applications brought to the Permit Sales Office must be received by 3:30 p.m. on February 11, 2013.**

- <u>DNR CUSTOMER NUMBER:</u> ALL applicants are required to provide a DNR Customer Number. Individuals who do not yet have a
 DNR Customer Number will need to obtain one before applying for a Fort McCoy permit. Contact a WDNR Service Center or call
 their toll free number at 1-888-936-7463 (7 days a week from 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM) to have one created. Applications without
 the DNR Customer Number will be returned.
- <u>SELECTION PROCESS AND CATEGORIES:</u> <u>ALL</u> applicants are required to identify their status (Category A, B, C). Military personnel, Fort McCoy civilians, and the general public **all** need to apply during the application period to have an opportunity to obtain a permit. Any applications without a category selected <u>or</u> without proper category verification (see below) will be entered into the Category C drawing.
- <u>Category A:</u> Active and Retired Military, Reserves and National Guard and military dependent ID card holders. <u>A Copy of Military ID is required with all Category A applications.</u> Any social security number displayed on the copy of your ID must be BLOCKED OUT.
- <u>Category B:</u> Department of Defense (DoD) and Non-Appropriated Fund (NAF) civilians, retired government civilians, other US Government Civilian ID Card Holders, and legal dependents (spouses and children 18 years old and younger). <u>A Copy of Civilian/Retired Civilian government employee ID is required with application.</u> Retired government civilian employees may supply a copy of their retirement SF50 or a retired civilian ID card. <u>Legal dependents must fill out the affidavit on the application and provide copy of parent/guardian government employee ID. Any social security number displayed on the copy of your ID must be BLOCKED OUT.</u> The Fort McCoy Personnel Services Branch can issue ID cards for retired civilian personnel. ID cards are issued in Building 2187 from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Please call (608) 388-4563 prior to visiting.
- Category C: General Public (those who do not qualify for Category A or B). No copy of ID required.
- GROUP APPLICATIONS: A maximum of 4 applications may be sent per envelope. All applications submitted in one envelope as a group must be the same category (A, B, or C) and for the same time period. Any groups with multiple categories will be included in the drawing at the lowest category (i.e., a group with Category A and C applications will be included in the Category C drawing). Youth (10 and 11 yrs) applications can be mailed along with, and in addition to, any group application and does not count towards the maximum of 4 applications per envelope. Each applicant, including youth, must submit a separate application with their correct mailing address. Each applicant within a group will be mailed notification of selection(s). Successful applicants will receive notification of their selection(s) and instructions on how to purchase their permit from an authorized WDNR ALIS agent.
- <u>PERMIT COST and PAYMENT: PAYMENT IS NOT REQUIRED AT TIME OF APPLICATION</u>. Successful applicants will receive notification to purchase their permit from a WDNR ALIS agent. **Permits are non-refundable/non-transferable.**
- <u>TIMEPERIODS</u>: The 2013 Spring Turkey hunting season on Fort McCoy consists of 6 hunting periods: **April 10-12**, **April 15-19**, **April 22-26**, **April 29-May 3**, **May 6-10**, and **May 13-17**.
- <u>SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS</u>: Successful applicants will be mailed a notification of selection indicating the time period for which they are authorized to hunt, a Fort McCoy Spring Turkey Regulation, and instruction on how to purchase the permit. All persons that receive a Fort McCoy Spring Turkey Permit must purchase/possess the appropriate Wisconsin hunting license (e.g. 2013 Spring Turkey Hunting License, Senior Citizen Recreation Card or Conservation Patron License, and Turkey Stamp if required by the state). Unsuccessful applicants will also receive notification of the selection results.
- <u>Selection Notification</u>: Notifications should be mailed out by **March 11, 2013**. Please do not call Permit Sales regarding whether you have received a permit until March 14, 2013. **Please keep this sheet and any other information (time periods you applied for and who you applied with) for future reference and if you have guestions for us.**

Any groups with multiple categories will be included in the drawing at the lowest category (i.e., a group with Category A and C applications will be included in the Category C drawing). Youth (10 and 11 yrs) applications can be mailed along with, and in addition to, any group application and does not count towards the maximum of 4 applications per envelope. Each applicant, including youth, must submit a separate application with their correct mailing address. Each applicant within a group will be mailed notification of selection(s). Successful applicants will receive notification of their selection(s) and instructions on how to purchase their permit from an authorized WDNR ALIS agent.
