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#### MATH COUNTS

These Mathletes (Alex Soto not pictured) have been training and preparing for the MathCounts Competitions since October. MathCounts is a challenging academic program where middle school students solve Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, and Discrete Math problems like the following:

\*It takes Mickey a total of 45 minutes to ride his bike 5 miles to Minnie's house and then walk the remaining mile to school with her. If he rides his bike the entire distance to school at the same rate he rode to Minnie's house, it will take him 30 minutes. What is his walking speed, in miles per hour?

\*The mean of the increasing ordered set of numbers, (6, x, 22), is equal to the median. What is the value of x?

\*The line 2x - 3x = -3 is graphed and then reflected over the x-axis. If the equation of its reflection is y =mx + b, what is the value of m + b? Express your answer as a common fraction.

After taking a 2 hour test on January 19th, the following students advanced to the next level test, the Math-Counts Chapter Competition: Jonas Knudsen, Matthew Burbee, Ben Mauldin, and Young Park. They will represent OMS on February 11th. Joy Kim and Kasen Stephensen are the alternates.
