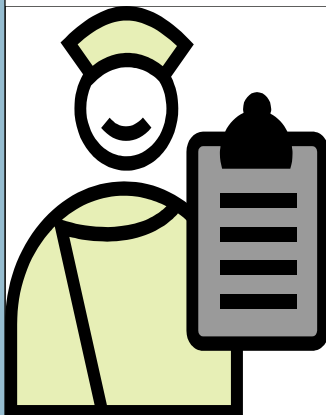

Our Program provides an excellent opportunity for Youth ages 14 – 17 yrs to volunteer in and contribute to our Osan community while having a great time doing it! Below are important program instructions and dates.

Veterinary placements are open to Youth ages 15-17 yrs, and are filled on a first come – first served basis. Personal preferences are considered; however, the needs of the various clinics and placement locations will be an important factor in placement.

Application Deadline: Applications are due back at the Red Cross office no later than 18 June 2011. Due to the overwhelming response to the program; late applications will only be accepted from individuals that PCS'd into the area after the deadline.

Orientation Location: Osan Base Theater

Attendance at the Orientation is MANDATORY for the Youth Participant and for, at least, one parent or guardian.
