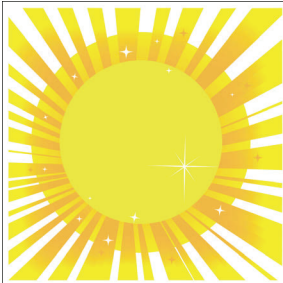
## SCIENCE FAIR

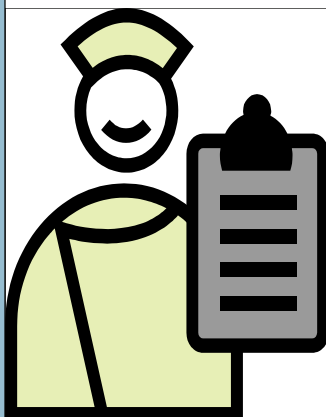
