

**UNOFFICIAL UNCLASSIFIED FLIGHTLINE PHOTOGRAPHY**

**PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT**

**AUTHORITY:** 10 U.S.C. 8012, and EO 9397.

**PRINCIPLE PURPOSE:** To ensure proper security measures are taken with individuals who use photography equipment in the restricted area. SSN is used for positive identification.

**ROUTINE USE:** Information may be disclosed to security personnel for identification purposes only.

**DISCLOSURE IS VOLUNTARY:** Failure to provide the information may mean that authorization may not be granted.

**THE ESCORT MUST READ THE FOLLOWING RULES AND SIGN IN ACKNOWLEDGMENT**

1. Photography outside the time frame, date, or location, or in violation of the safety and security rules outlined on this form, is not authorized and may subject the individuals concerned to appropriate administrative action.
2. The authorization given by this form is temporary, and the 2nd Security Police Squadron may cancel the flightline photography and escort all concerned individuals out of the restricted area at any time.
3. If this form is altered, i.e. correction fluid, erasures, etc., without proper authentication measures taken, it is null and void.
4. This form, with signed approval, must be in the escort's possession during the period that photographs are taken.
5. The escort or anyone being escorted, will not knowingly photograph any classified or sensitive equipment or information, and if there is concern about what is being photographed, the individual will readily give the exposed film to security police personnel or a designated representative for processing and screening. The escort will receive the film after screening if security has not been violated.

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## **UNOFFICIAL UNCLASSIFIED FLIGHTLINE PHOTOGRAPHY PROCEDURES**

**STEP 1** – You will receive a call from a member requesting unofficial flightline photos (the most common is a photo of a B-52, for family/friends)

**STEP 2** – Have the ESCORT (the one with the linebadge who will bring his family/friends out to the flightline) complete the BARK Form 77. (*Only the ESCORT may complete the form*)

**STEP 3** – The escort must have his/her linebadge when completing the form.

**STEP 4** – Before approval can be given, the escort must read the rules and list all members of his/her group. The escort must sign both sides of the forms.

**STEP 5** – Only approve the form when the linebadge, name, badge number, and Social Security number match.

- Check approve, sign and date the form.

**STEP 6** – Make 1 copy of the form, give the escort the original.

**STEP 7** – The escort must take the original to the 2d Security Forces, Central Security Control (CSC), Hangar 3, 6-1120.
