

Command-Directed Mental Health Evaluations:

- 1) Mental Health Evaluations can be Command-directed, in which case
 - a. a member on DSG status or Technician status may be placed on active duty orders in order to be evaluated. The member can be evaluated at Davis-Monthan AFB, or the VA (if on a weekend).
 - b. a member on AGR status will be evaluated at Davis-Monthan AFB.
- 2) If a diagnosis of PTSD is made by a provider at Davis-Monthan AFB, the VA, or a civilian provider, Line of Duty paperwork should be initiated by the Force Health Management office.
- 3) Any medical records from a civilian provider (private doctor or VA) should be given to the Force Health Management office.

Mental Health Issues Identified Through the PDHRA Process

Public Health and Force Health Management receives notification through the PHDRA process that a member has answered positively to a question concerning Mental Health. A records review is done by Force Health Management to determine need for initiation of Line of Duty paperwork.
