

Cleanup Process








Location of Parcels D-1 and UC-1



Remedy for Soil




- Dig/remove soil at Parcel D-1 only
 - 6 areas for PAHs
 - Approximately 504 cubic yards of soil (~42 truck loads)
- Dispose contaminated soil at off-site facility
- Install durable covers
 - Physical barriers to cut off potential exposure to metals in soil
- Implement land use controls



Soil Remediation Areas







Remedy for Groundwater



- Inject food for contaminant-eating bacteria or an iron product into several small groundwater plumes to destroy contaminants and immobilize some metals
- Monitor groundwater to track remedy effectiveness
- Implement land use controls



Remedy for Radiologically Impacted Soil and Structures




- Survey buildings and former building sites for radiation
- Decontaminate buildings, demolish if necessary
- Remove radiologically impacted storm drain and sanitary sewer lines
- Remove contaminated soils at impacted sites
- Dispose waste at an off-site facility
