### **PHASE**

### PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT/ SITE INSPECTION



### **Preliminary Assessment/Site Inspection -**

An initial review of the site, including review of historic records and visual inspections. Sampling and analysis of soil, surface water, and/or groundwater may occur to evaluate whether the site needs to move to the next phase for further investigations.

### REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION



# **Remedial Investigation** - A closer look, including collecting and analyzing samples to assess risk to human health and the environment. A Removal Action may also be performed at this

point.

### FEASIBILITY STUDY



**Feasibility Study** - Results of the risk assessments, along with the data collected during the Remedial Investigation are used to evaluate cleanup alternatives that have been screened for effectiveness, implementability, and cost.

#### PROPOSED PLAN



**Proposed Plan** - A fact sheet that describes cleanup alternatives evaluated in the Feasibility Study and explains the preferred alternative. This step requires a meeting be held to provide information to the public and allow the public to comment on the preferred alternative.

### RECORD OF DECISION



**Record of Decision** - The selected cleanup alternative is documented and publicized in this document. A summary and responses to all comments on the Proposed Plan are included in this document.

### REMEDIAL DESIGN



**Remedial Design** - A design for implementing the selected cleanup alternative is prepared. A fact sheet is sent to the public before the Navy begins work on the cleanup remedy.

### REMEDIAL ACTION



**Remedial Action** - The cleanup remedy is carried out and the public is kept informed.
