The Armed Forces Vacation Club is a "space available" program offering Department of Defense-affiliated personnel affordable vacations at more than 3,500 resorts around the world. There are no membership applications to fill out, fees or dues to pay or timeshare presentations to attend.

The Space-A rental rate is a flat rate of \$329* (not including taxes) per week for the unit, regardless of unit size, unit occupancy, unit configuration, date or location.

You can spend a week in Five-Star accommodations, literally anywhere in the world; you pick the location. Long-term planning and reservations are NOT required, just visit the Web site and pick a location. The Web site will inform you of all open dates and options available.
