Lear Siegler Services work at New Boston site ends March

ROCK ISLAND ARSENAL, III. –In The U.S. Army Sustainment Command (ASC) has announced that its time and materials task order under the Field and Installation Readiness Support Team (FIRST) contract with Lear Siegler Services, Inc. will be complete as of March 28.

The task order supports maintenance operations for ASC's Army Field Logistics Readiness Division. The task order is for a base period of one year with four option years, with the second option year scheduled to end on March 28. The place of performance is at a contractor leased and operated facility in New Boston, Texas.

The company currently employs about 125 people. The estimated economic impact of the contract is about \$6 million.

The Army Field Logistics Readiness Division conducted a thorough review of maintenance workload requirements and determined the capacity at the New Boston facility to be excess to the Army's needs. Therefore, ASC decided not to exercise a third option year.

All work performed at the New Boston facility is contracted for, and funded by, Red River Army Depot (RRAD). Depot officials have determined that RRAD has the capability and capacity to perform the workload, and will take it over from Lear Siegler Services. The impact of this decision on employment levels at RRAD is unknown at this time.
