402nd AFSB Soldier meets Olympic medalist

Sgt. 1st Class Barbara Bossier, first sergeant of Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 402nd Army Field Support Brigade, Joint Base Balad, Iraq, poses with Johnny Spillane and the three silver medals he won at the 2010 Winter Olympic Games in Vancouver, Canada. Spillane is the first American ever to receive an Olympic medal in the sport of Nordic Combined that consists of ski jumping and cross country skiing. He was joined by his silver medal-winning Nordic Combined teammates Brett Camerota, Todd Lodwick, and Billy Demong on the Armed Forces Entertainment "Heavy Medal Tour" that took them to bases in Europe and Southwest Asia. In all, the team garnered seven medals, including Demong's gold in the large hill event. Bossier, from Lafayette, La., is an Army Reservist with the 377th Theater Support Command in New Orleans, La.
