Leaders, NCOs, enlisted personnel, government civilians, contractors ... we need everyone's help to take proactive measures to promote this campaign and ensure the message of motorcycle safety is spread to all levels. Identify the motorcycle riders in your organization. Ensure they have a Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) card. Use your red stop card to halt unsafe riding acts or report it to a supervisor. Include motorcycle safety in daily briefings and unit gatherings. Use your mentorship program and any other necessary means to help promote this campaign.
