

## **Remote Sensing License Summary**

On November 17, 2010 the National Environmental Satellite, Data and Information Service of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, an agency of the Department of Commerce, granted a license to University of California, Irvine to operate a private, space-based, remote sensing system named "UCISAT-1." UCISAT-1 is a 10cm x 10cm x 10cm cubesat equipped with a cell phone camera to take pictures of the northern hemisphere. The UCISAT-1 will be launched in a 300km altitude, polar orbit.
