FAMILY ADVOCACY PROGRAM:

Located at the Department of Social Work and Army Community Service provides

Commanders with assistance in addressing the problems of spouse and child abuse. Provides information and education to support strong self-reliant families and enhance coping skills. It also provides early identification and treatment services to Soldiers and their families involved in family violence. This program strives to end violence in the home and assists individuals in establishing and maintaining positive non-violent relationships.





SOCIAL WORK SERVICES:

- Counseling for deployment-related issues (Care Managers)
- Individual counseling
- Marriage and family counseling
- Child & Adolescent Therapy Program
- Postpartum support
- Sexual assault counseling
- Support to inpatient wards
- Outreach (Unit briefings, command consultation, and community education)
- Information and referral

TREATMENT GROUPS OFFERED

ANGER MANAGEMENT GROUP: Teaches participants ways to appropriately manage anger and consciously refrain from using violence.

COUPLES CONFLICT RESOLUTION GROUP: A one time 1 1/2 hour session offered by DSW for couples who could benefit from learning new skills to help them resolve their conflicts.

DADS 101: A program for first time fathers. Promotes healthy bonding with newborn child.

IMPACT OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ON CHILDREN:

Psycho-educational group to educate parents on how violence in the home affects children.

MARCHING TO CHANGE TREATMENT PROGRAM:

Clinical intervention designed to increase positive coping skills, promote a nonviolent home environment, and encourage self-growth.

OPERATION ENDURING RELATIONSHIP: Enhancing Couples Communication: Communication is the key to a lasting relationship. This group is designed for couples who desire to improve effective communication skills.

POST PARTUM EMPOWERMENT GROUP: Provides treatment and support for women experiencing depressive symptoms before and after childbirth.

STRESS MANAGEMENT GROUP: Provides a forum for participants to discuss issues related to managing stress.

SOLDIER SUPPORT GROUP: A support group for Soldiers coping with the loss of a battle buddy, a family member, a friend's suicide or the loss of a relationship.

WOMEN'S GROUP: A psycho-educational/support group for women who have been involved in domestic violence or feel that they are in an abusive relationship.
