#### Fairchild Air Force Base

The 92nd Air Refueling Wing is host unit to Team Fairchild - comprised of the 141st Air Refueling Wing, the 336th Training Group and 15 other tenant organizations. Team Fairchild encompasses 4,700 active duty, reserve, guard members and civilian employees.

The 92nd ARW is responsible for providing air refueling, as well as rapid and reliable passenger and



cargo airlift and aero-medical evacuation missions supporting U.S. and coalition conventional operations as well as U.S. Strategic Com-

mand strategic deterrence missions. Fairchild directly supports Air Mobility Command's mission, providing global reach air power and deploying expeditionary combat support forces in support of worldwide contingency requirements. The 92nd ARW capability of aerial refueling enhances the Air Force's ability to accomplish its primary missions of Global Reach and Global Power.

The wing is designated as one of five Air Force Lead

Mobility Wings on September 1, 2000, responsible for providing rapid response to world wide humanitarian assistance or disaster relief contingen-



cies. The wing can deploy anywhere in the world with a 32 member Initial Response Team, assess a situation and prepare for follow-on forces.

Fairchild currently has 35 KC-135 aircraft assigned. These aircraft and the dedicated members of Team Fairchild continue to actively support Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM, NOBLE EAGLE and missions throughout the world. The 92nd ARW is proud to provide the best Global Reach for America, helping to make the world safe for our future.
