The National Nuclear Data Center is organizing the 2013 International Conference on Nuclear Data for Science and Technology (ND2013).

The conference will be held on March 4-8, 2013 at the Sheraton New York Hotel & Towers in Manhattan, NY, USA.

The program will consist of plenary, invited, and featured talks, as well as poster sessions. Information on registration, abstract submission and lodging can be found ND2013 web site, www.bnl.gov/nd2013

Registration

The registration is now open at the ND2013 webpage at www.bnl.gov/nd2013

In addition to the participant's name and current address, we'll ask about possible interest in attending the conference dinner, the cost of which will not be included in the registration fee, as well as attending an optional evening Opera performance and/or a Broadway show. This information is not binding and will only be used to assist us with the planning.

Abstract Submission

A link to submit abstracts for oral and poster presentations is available at the conference web site. The password to access the abstract submission page will be generated during the registration process and sent by e-mail.

Please note that special characters in the abstract should be entered in the LaTeX format.

The deadline to submit abstracts is August 1st, 2012. The abstracts will be reviewed and we expect to inform participants of the status of their presentations by September 1st, 2012.



Proceedings

Following a refereeing process, the contributed articles will be published in the Nuclear Data Sheets journal. Poster presentations will appear only in the electronic version of the journal, while oral presentations will also be published in the paper version.

Manuscripts must be submitted by the end of the conference. A LaTeX template and sample article will be posted on the conference web site shortly.

Authors submitting contributions which relate to a similar topic, for instance ENDF/B evaluations, will have the option, if desired, to merge their articles into a single, more comprehensive article. Please keep in mind that this only applies to articles in the proceedings, not to oral or poster presentations.

Registration Fee

The ND2013 registration fee will be \$700 until December 20th, 2012. After this date, the registration fee will be \$850. A 50% discount will be given to graduate students and post-docs making presentations.

Additionally, a discounted registration fee will be available to participants making presentations in the nuclear physics education session. Please send an e-mail to nd2013@bnl.gov if you'd like to take advantage of this possibility.

Payment of the registration fee will be done by check or credit card. We will start collecting the registration fee in July 2012.

Hotel room reservations

A block of 300 rooms has been reserved in the Sheraton at the March 2013 U.S. government lodging rate, plus taxes and fees. This rate is not yet known, however, as a reference, the March 2011 U.S. government rate was \$204 plus tax. The hotel is located half-way between Times Square and Central Park.

Participants are responsible for their own hotel reservations. The deadline to make hotel reservations is February 10th 2013.

We have very limited funds to help pay the lodging cost for graduate students, post-docs and participants contributing to the nuclear physics education session. Please let us know soon by e-mail if you will need assistance with lodging payment.

State Department registration

ND2013 has been registered with the US State Department; this should be of assistance to our international visitors who require a US visa.
