## Document Delivery

## Interlibrary Loan

The public may not check out items from the USGS Library. Certain items may be borrowed through interlibrary loan (ILL) between our library and your library (such as a corporate library, public library, school library, university library, etc.). Submit ILL requests with a standard American Library Association "ALA Interlibrary Loan Request Form," either mailed or hand carried. Pre-approval of your library is needed to submit hand carried ILL requests. Requests may also be submitted by OCLC's electronic interlibrary loan subsystem. Our OCLC library symbol is "GIS." Your school or public library reference librarian will be able to help you with your request.
