## You must meet the following requirements:

- Applicant must possess at least an ENTNAC or a NAC security clearance.
- You must be currently medically qualified IAW AFI 48-123, and must meet the fitness requirements of AFI 36-2905.

## **Specialty Qualifications:**

**Knowledge** is mandatory of basic epidemiology, microbiology, food technology and hygiene, communicable diseases, and occupational health.

**Education**. For entry into this specialty, it is mandatory to possess either: a Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine (DVM/VMD), Public Health (DrPH), Epidemiology (PhD), or a bachelor's degree in a biological science (see Note), and a Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) degree in public health/environmental medicine technology; or a Master's Degree in Public Health (MPH/MSPH) or Epidemiology (MS), and a bachelor's degree in a biological science (see Note). All degrees must emanate from academic institutions recognized by the Surgeon General, HQ USAF. Also, all MPH or equivalent degrees must be from schools or programs (including distance learning) listed as fully accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH).

If entry is based on a bachelor's degree in a biological science (see Note) with a CCAF degree in public health/environmental technology, seven years of job experience as an enlisted public health technician is required. Three of the seven years must be as a 7-skill level enlisted public health technician (AFSC 4E071).

**NOTE:** A degree in nursing (BSN/RN), biology, microbiology or zoology, or other degree containing, at a minimum, the following semester-hour equivalents: biology with laboratory, 8 hours; chemistry with laboratory, 8 hours; organic chemistry with laboratory, 8 hours; physics with laboratory, 8 hours; microbiology with laboratory, 4 hours; genetics, 3 hours; biology electives, 9 hours; and statistics, 3 hours.
