MEMORANDUM FOR All Units Training at the Marseilles Training Center

SUBJECT: Marseilles Training Center Usage Restrictions

1. The Marseilles Training Center (MTC) consists of approximately 200 acres. The remainder of MTC, approximately 2600 acres, is the property of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR).
2. IDNR allows the Illinois National Guard usage of the 2600 acres for the majority of the year. It is imperative that we in the Illinois National Guard maintain positive relations with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources.
3. MTC ranges and training areas are unavailable because of hunting during the following times:
 - a. First weekend of September – All live fire ranges and training areas.
 - b. After the first weekend in September, Monday – Thursday until 31 October. Except the Northern Use Area.
 - c. 1 November until 10 January – All live fire ranges and training areas.
 - d. Spring turkey hunting, Monday - Thursday TBD (12 April 2010 to 13 May 2010).
4. The Northern Use Area comprises training areas, 102N, 102E, 103W and portions of 102S, 104C and 103E.
5. Reference: Memorandum of Agreement between the Illinois Department of Military Affairs and the Illinois Department of Natural Resources dated 1999. This MOA is signed by the Governor and The Adjutant General of the State Illinois.
