- 1. **Before the Season** Assemble your disaster supply kit and prepare your individual, family, and/or business plan.
- 2. When a Tropical Storm or Hurricane Watch is issued (48 hrs from storm arrival) Check your disaster kit and replenish items if necessary, begin preparations around your home, and activate your plan.
- 3. When a Tropical Storm or Hurricane Warning is issued (36 hrs from storm arrival) Follow pertinent civil defense of emergency management evacuation orders, ready your disaster kit, and prepare for arrival of tropical cyclone hazards. Get to a safe place and prepare to wait out the storm.

Following these steps could make the difference for you and your loved ones. Do not hesitate, start to prepare today!
