
(2) For Base Maintenance projects:

(b) Base Maintenance will notify the MCB Environmental Engineer and provide written notification per paragraph 1.

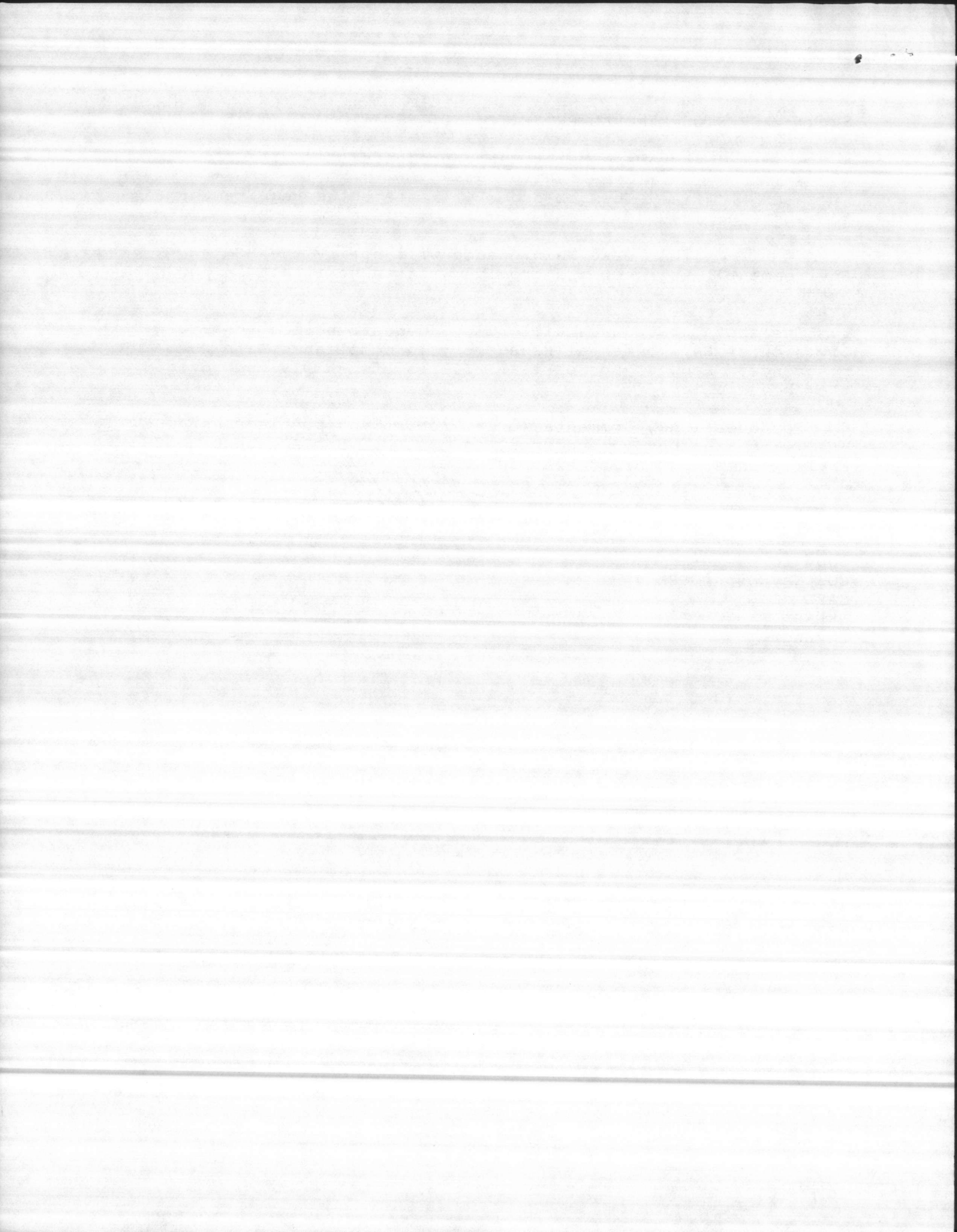

1. Request future notification of asbestos removal projects be prepared by PWO and BMO for signature by the AC/S, Facilities. The format for these notices should conform to the enclosure and should include both the cover letter and the completed form. Further, request future notices to the State by contractors be discontinued because the obligation to notify and track these projects resides with the Commanding General, Marine Corps Base.

2. Copies of the "notice" form will be provided to the Base Safety office and the Naval Hospital (Head, O&PMD). For assistance in identification of asbestos to include sample collection and analyses, contact the Base Industrial Hygienist, ext. 5707. For assistance in asbestos project inspections and surveys, contact Base Safety, ext. 5725. The confirmed starting date for demolition/renovation should be announced to these offices as far in advance as possible.

3. The policy of this command regarding asbestos notices shall be applied as follows:

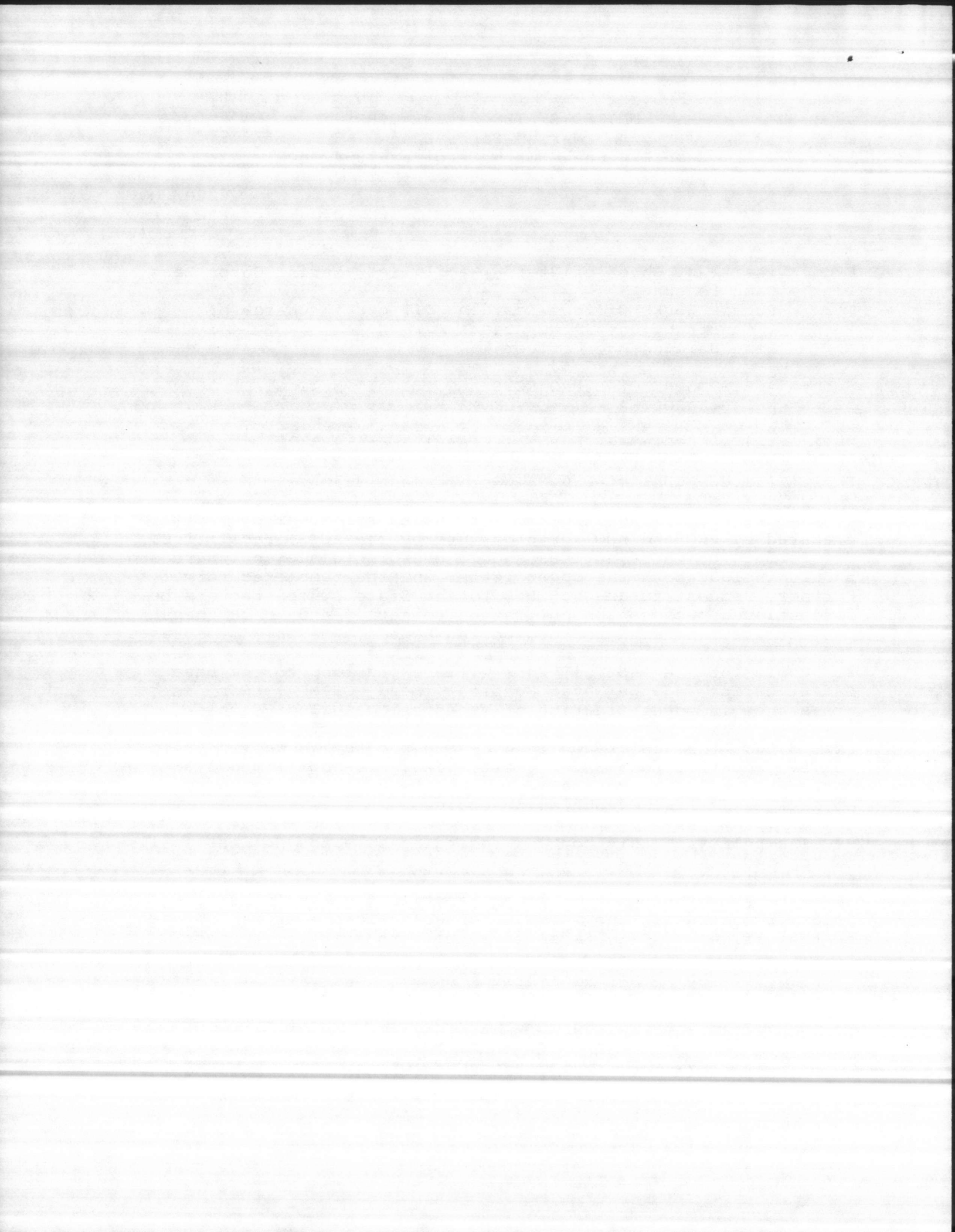
a. An advance notice of at least 15 days shall be given prior to initiating the work. Shorter notices must be approved by the office of AC/S, Facilities prior to starting the work.

b. Design specifications prepared for projects involving asbestos removal shall require the above notice.

(1) For contractor operations:

(a) The project specifications shall require the contractor to notify the ROICC of the date when removal is to begin as stated in paragraph 3a.

(b) The ROICC will provide the written notification for signature per paragraph 1.

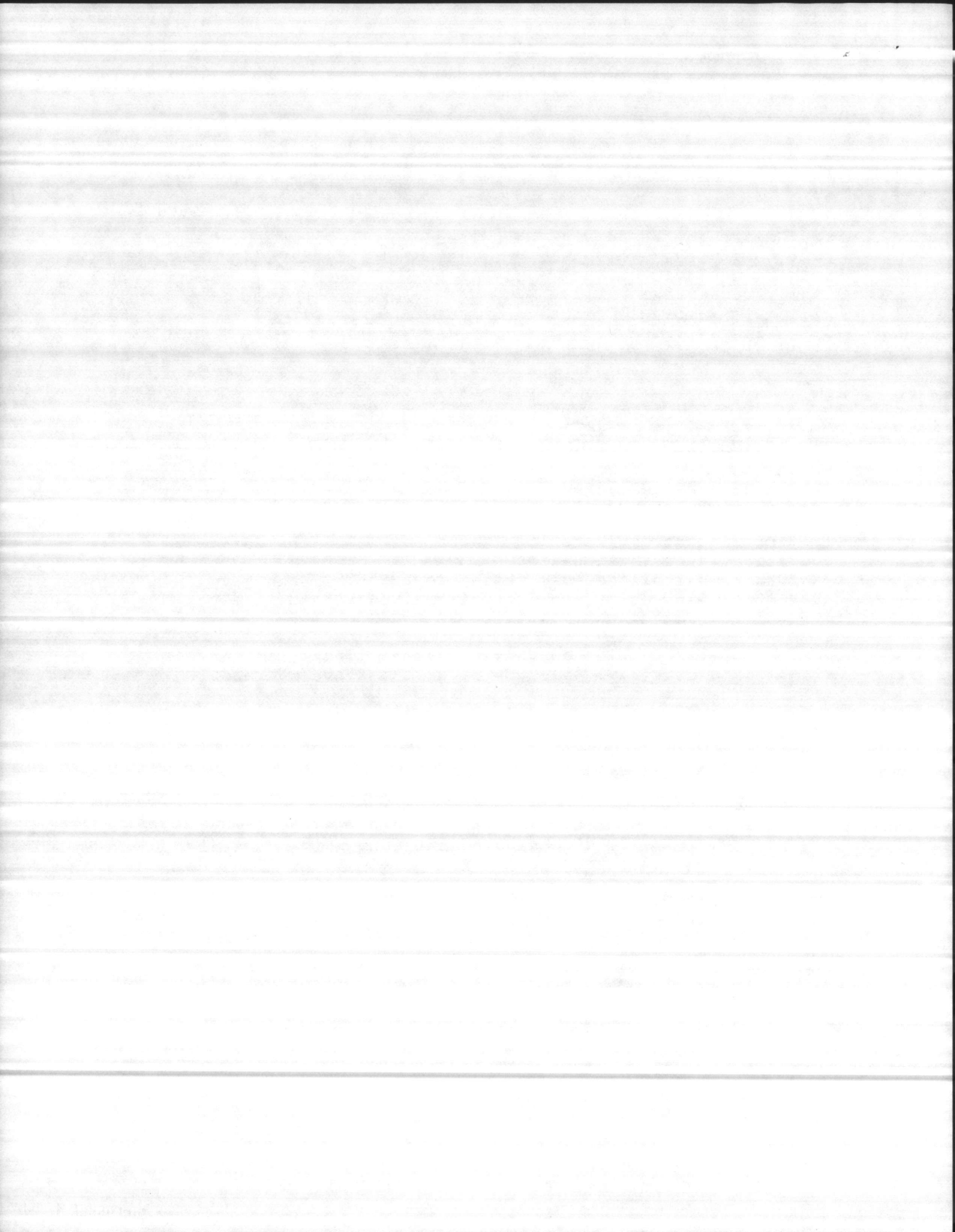
