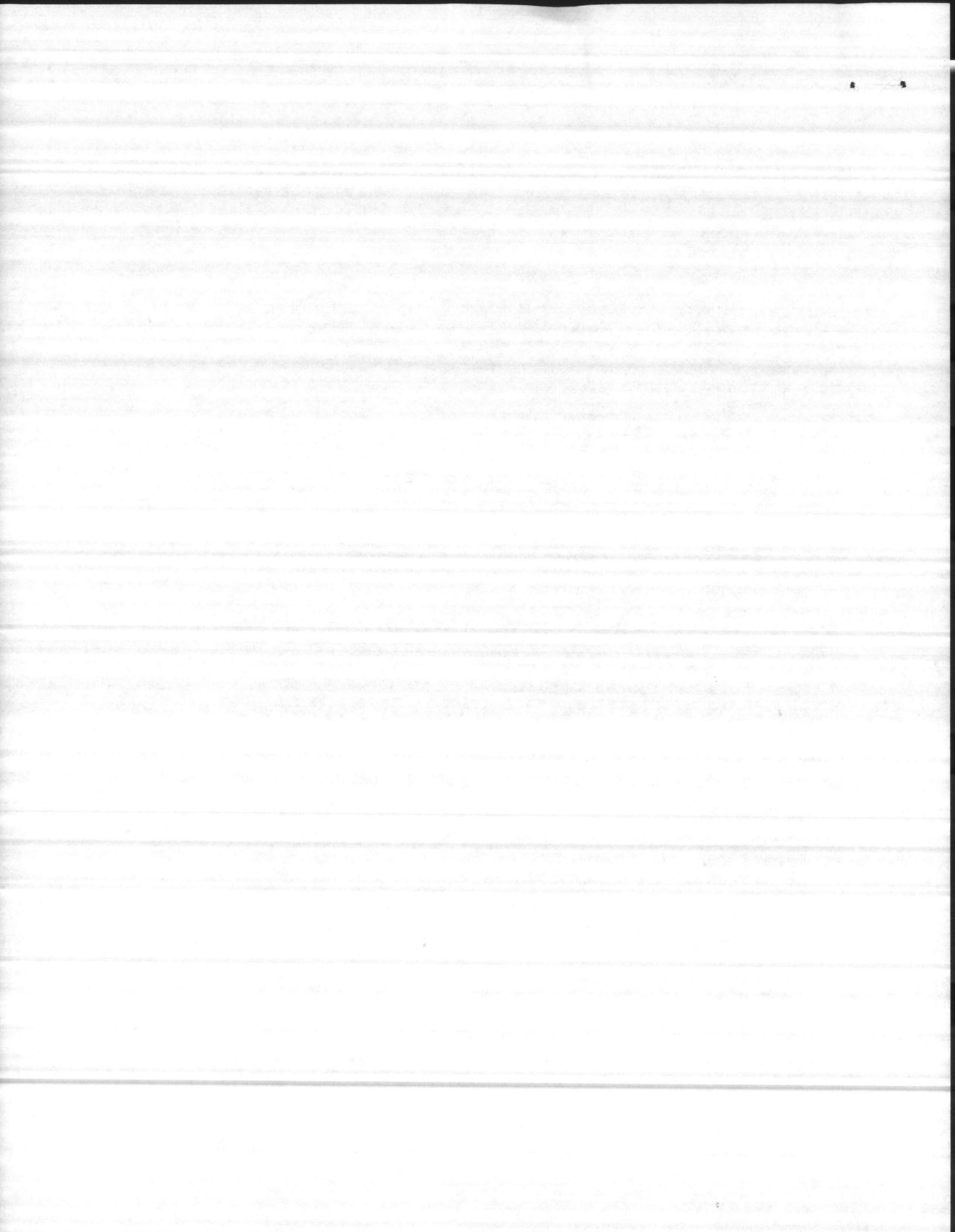
Subj: Amendments to School Permits

1. Enclosure (1) to reference (a) is returned, approved for execution on behalf of the Marine Corps.
2. The authority granted by reference (b) to execute amendments to the existing permits for school purposes from the Commissioner of Education, on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy, is hereby redelegated in this case to the Commanding General, Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Prior to execution, assign local field contract numbers to the proposed amendments for the purpose of ready identification.
3. The amendments permit increasing the limitation from \$500 to \$1,500 which the Marine Corps may spend for necessary reconstruction and maintenance repairs to school facilities without prior approval of the plans for such work by the Commissioner of Education. Experience has proved that the \$500 limitation is no longer realistic. The \$1,500 limitation has been incorporated in all use permits issued by the Commissioner of Education for the use and occupancy of school facilities completed during 1965.
4. Records indicate that the original incoming permits were executed at the local level with the exception of permit NOM-72418 for the operation of the Junior-Senior High School, which was executed at Headquarters level.
