Subj: REQUEST FOR USE OF FIRE HYDRANT

1. Returned, approved.
2. All future requests for use of a fire hydrant to clean equipment will be granted only when the following conditions exist:
  - a. Weather and terrain conditions make it impractical to use another unit's wash facility.
  - b. Tactical fire trucks are not available from 2d FSSG.
  - d. A proper hydrant wrench is used to open the hydrant valve.
3. Vehicle washdown on your lot is not environmentally sanctioned because of the run off into a freshwater stream. Using a fire hydrant is especially undesirable because of the large volume of water it produces. A project is funded and under design to construct an acceptable washdown facility at your building this fiscal year. Until that is completed, however, I urge you to seek alternate sources whenever possible.
4. By copy hereof, the Base Fire Chief is directed to approve future requests of this nature only when the above conditions are met.
