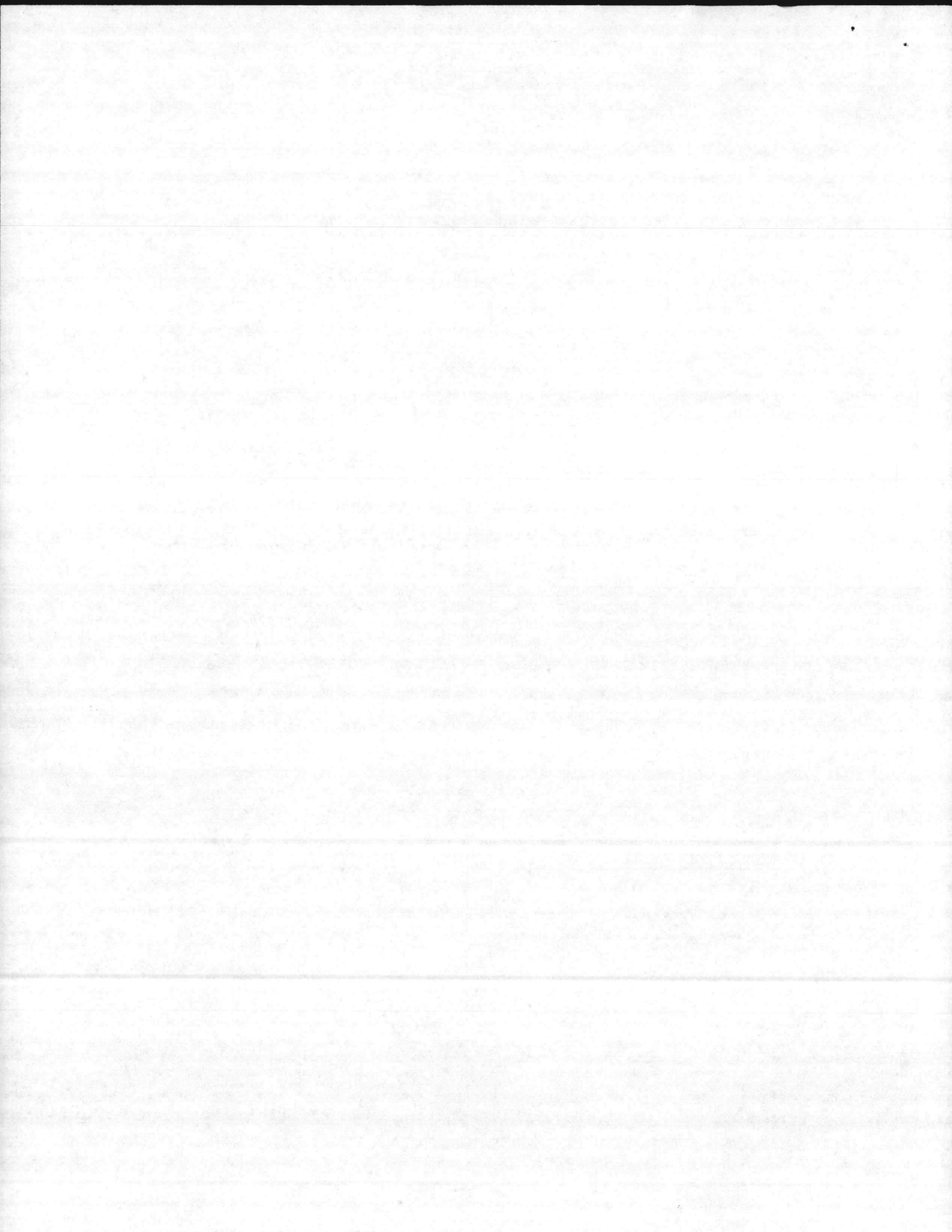

There is nothing in your letter to indicate that these permits have been returned for modification. If they are still in your possession, will you please return them to this office.

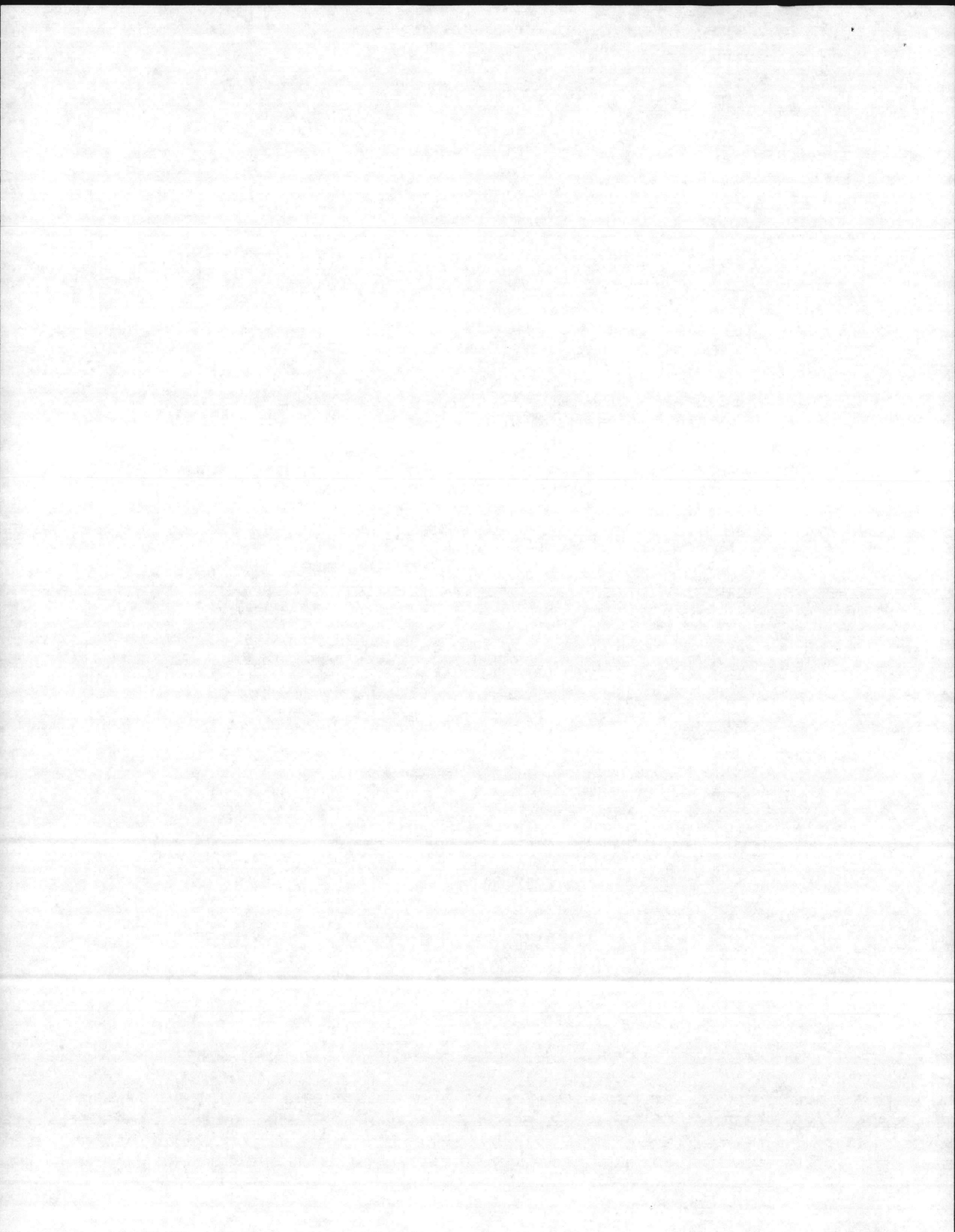

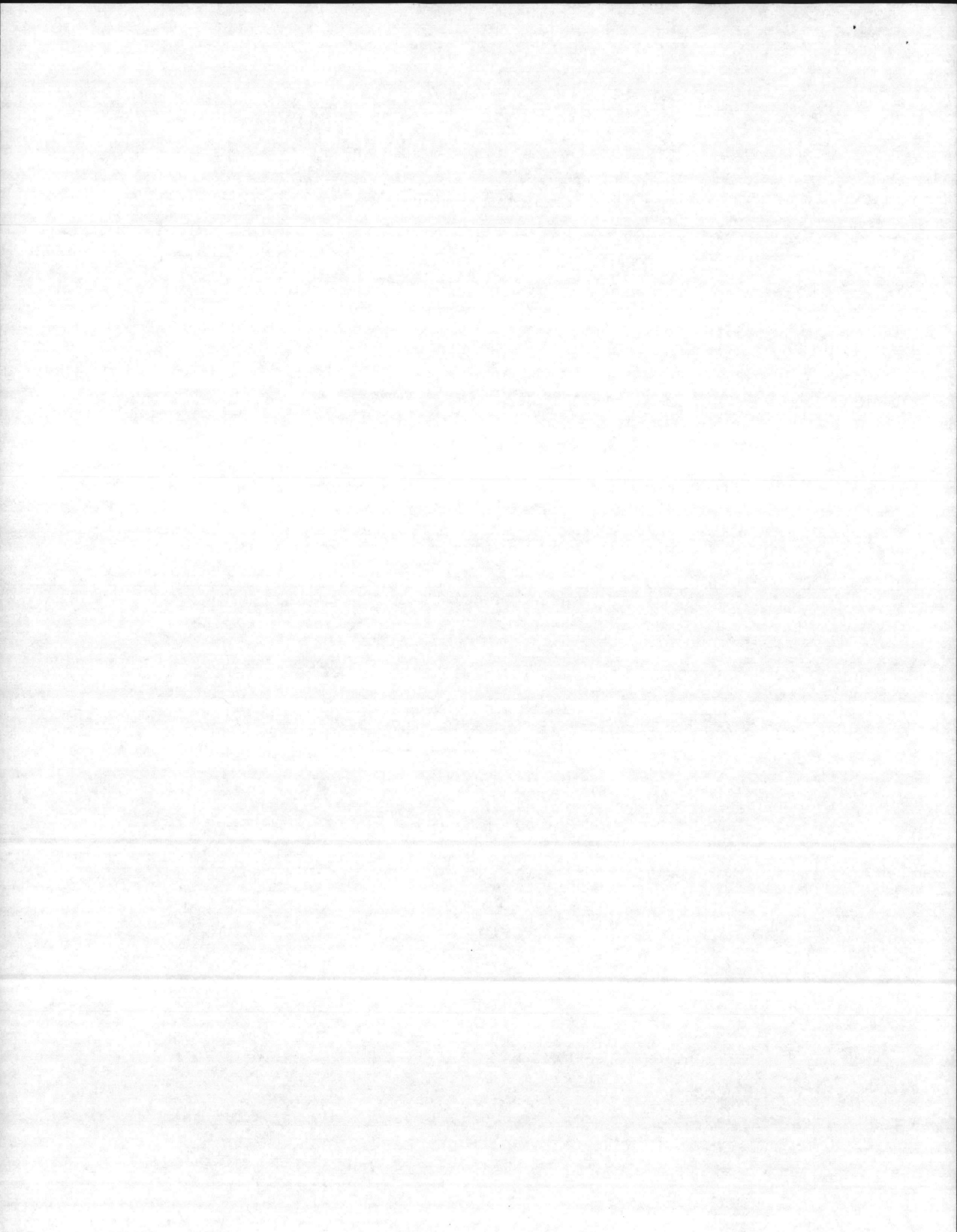

Dear Sir:

In re: Highway Right of Way Permit,
Onslow County Project 257.

We have yours of April 3, enclosing a proposed revocable permit for the right of way for the above project.

It is my understanding that this project is being built primarily for the benefit of Camp Lejeune and that the new location follows in a large degree an existing public right of way but departs from it in some particulars.

We had hoped that you would give us a right of way substantially in accordance with Section 18 of Title 23 of United States Code. This, in effect, gives the State the right of way so long as it is used for highway purposes, but for no other purpose. We have an agreement under this statute for the highway through Fort Bragg.

The permit proposed is not only objectionable because it is revocable at will but the proposed Section 5, under which this Commission is asked to enter into an indemnity agreement, not only for its own agents and employees but for any person operating a vehicle or other means of transportation upon the road, is so clearly beyond the powers of this Commission that we could not sign an agreement of that nature.

Surely there must be some more practical way to meet the situation.
