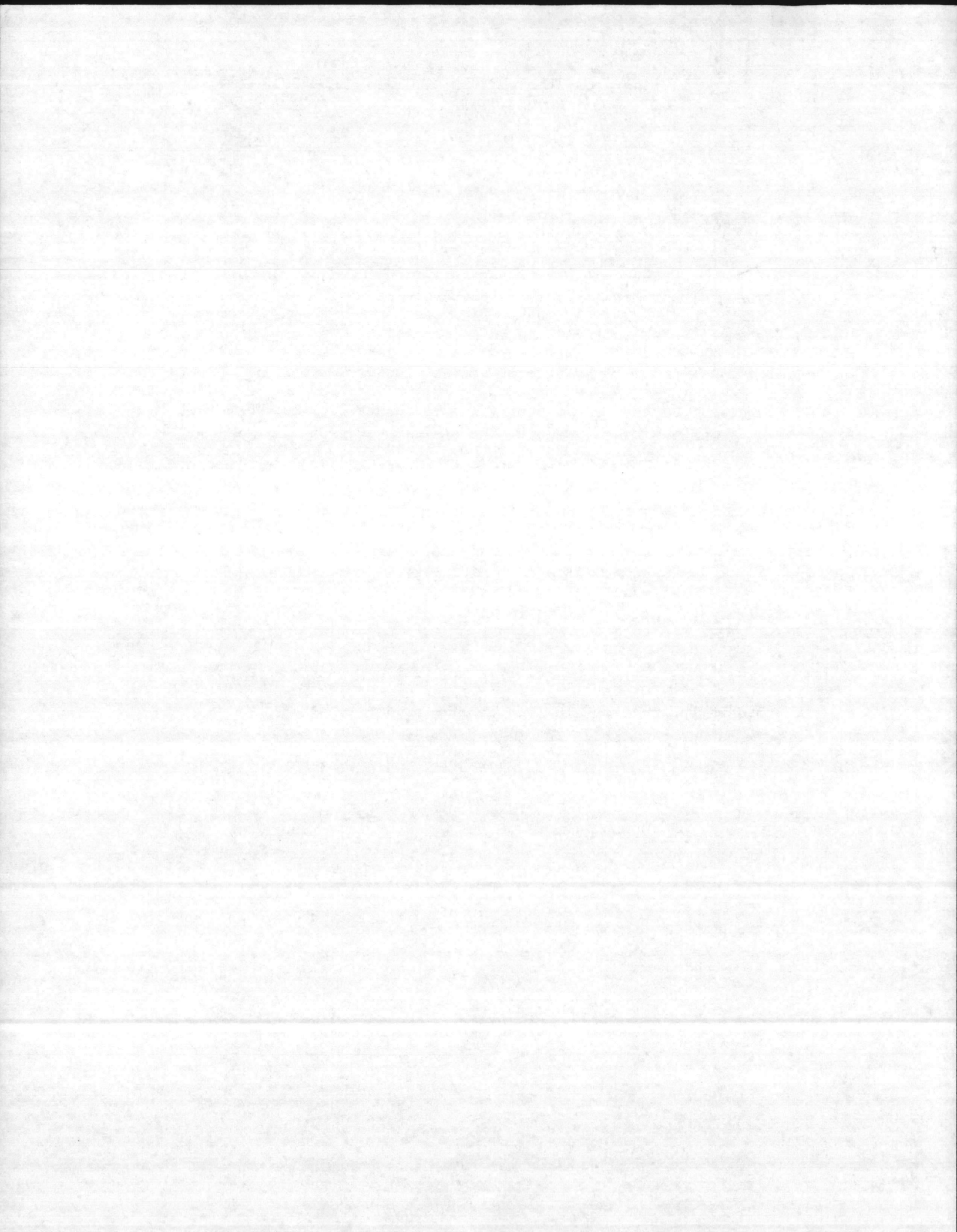

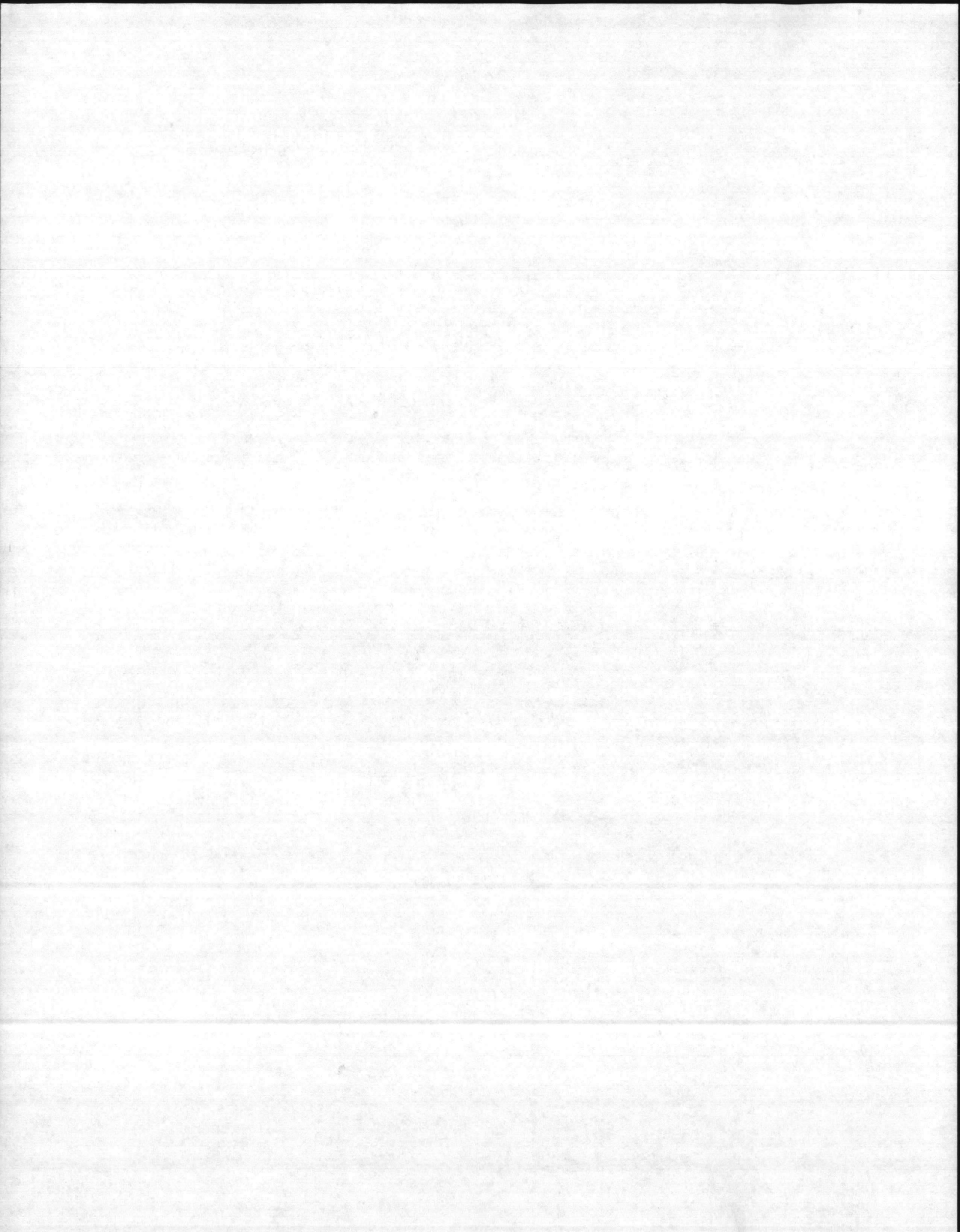

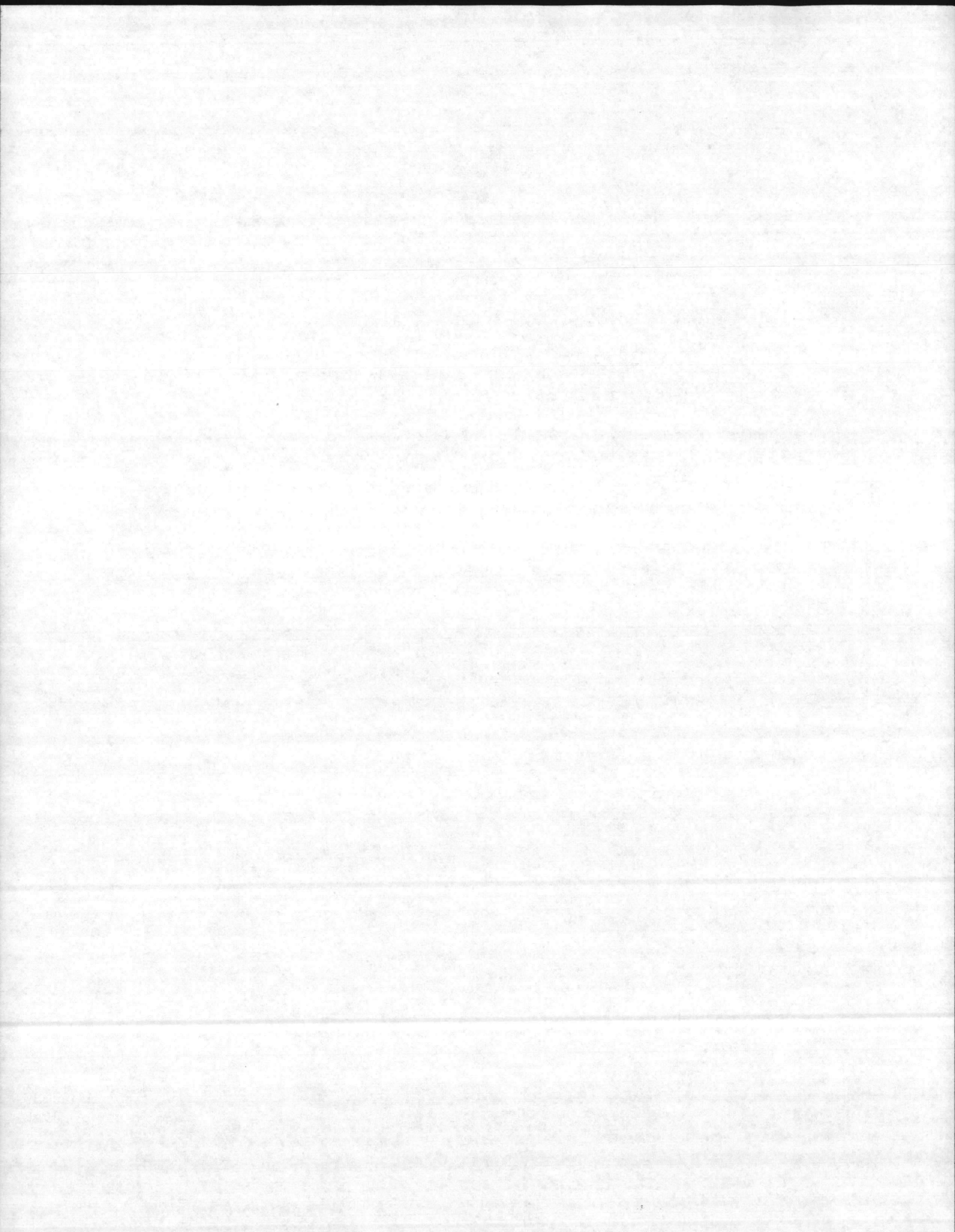

1. The draft of proposed revocable permit, forwarded to this Bureau by Reference (a) for review, has been re-written in order that it may conform to the established practice of the Bureau.

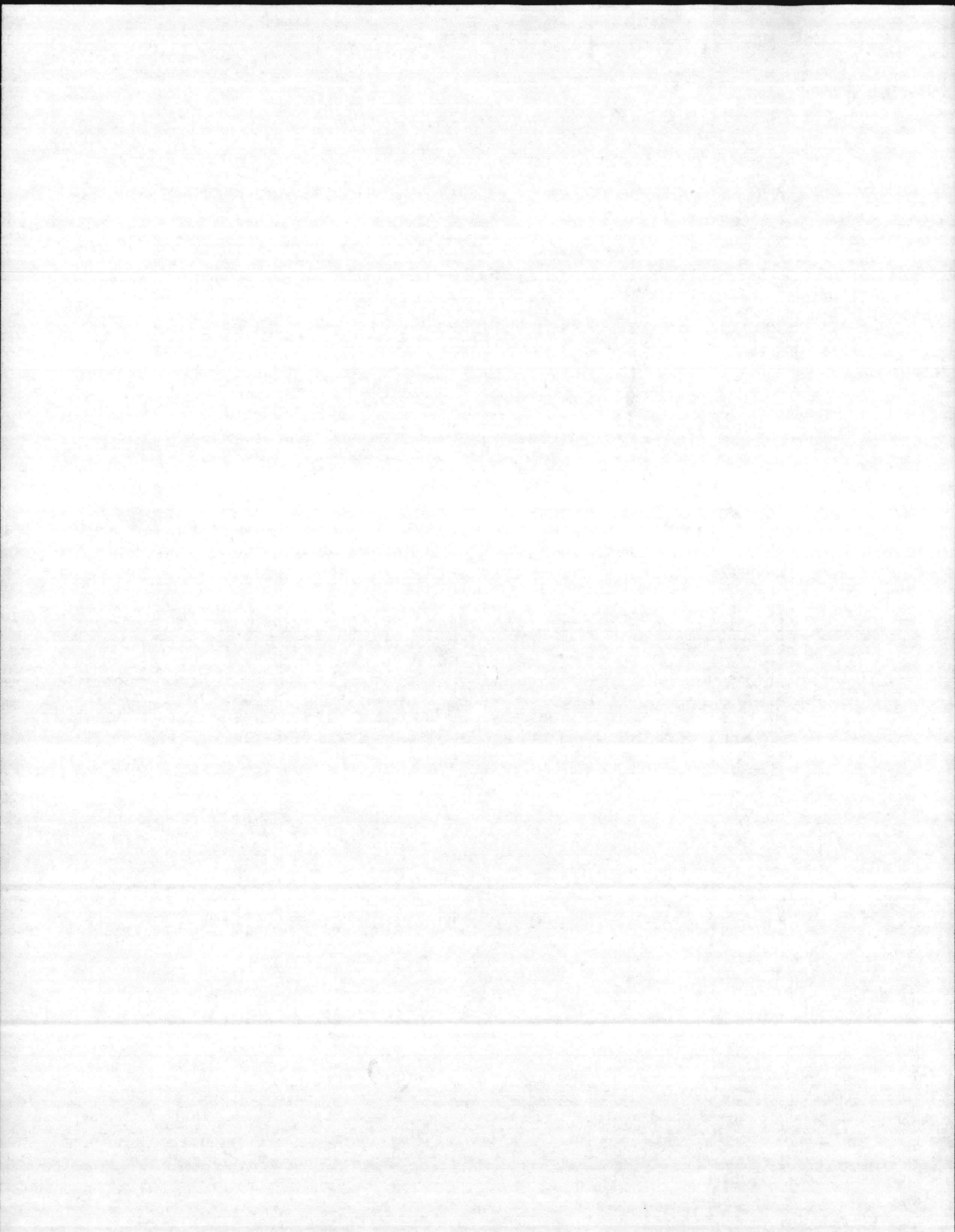

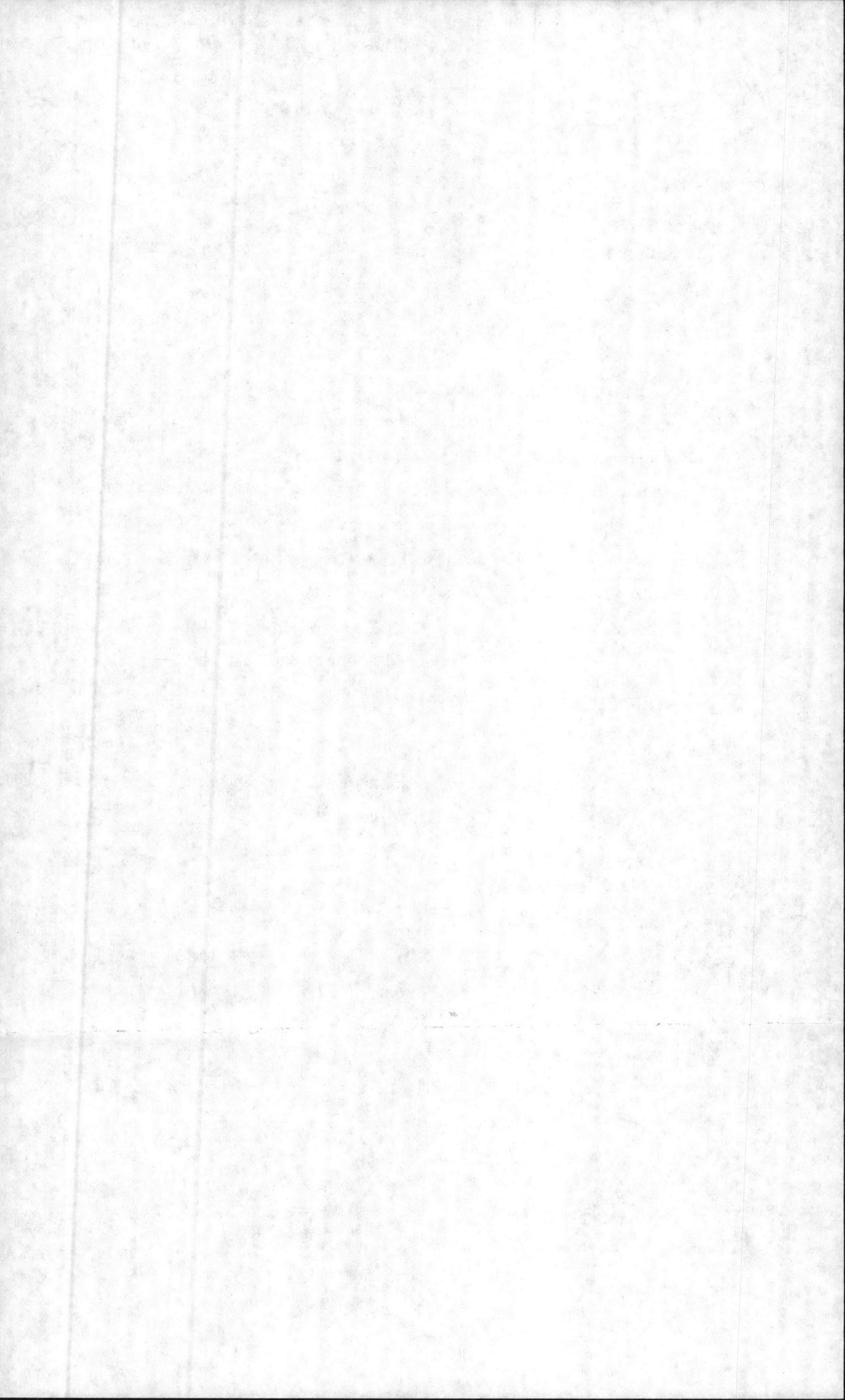


REVOCABLE PERMIT

IN CONSIDERATION of the benefits and advantages to be derived therefrom, THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, represented by the Chief of the Bureau of Yards and Docks, acting under the direction of the Secretary of the Navy, hereinafter called the Permitter, hereby grants unto CARTERET-CRAVEN ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION, a corporation doing business in the State of North Carolina, with a principal place of business at Morehead City, North Carolina, hereinafter called the Permittee, permission, revocable at will, to occupy and use a strip of land one hundred (100) feet long and twenty (20) feet wide, for the construction, maintenance, operation and repair of an electric power transmission line, across a portion of lands comprising the Marine Corps Barracks, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, at the location and in accordance with the details of a photostat of a drawing, dated January 10, 1948, bearing legend "Crossing Diagram Proposed 7200 volt crossing Under U.S. Marine Corp. 110 K.V. Transmission Line," attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

The permission hereby granted shall be subject to the following provisions and conditions:

1. This Permit shall not be assignable or transferable except upon the written consent of the Permitter, or by its duly authorized representative.
2. The Permittee is not to be considered as acquiring hereunder any permanent interest of whatever nature in the land of the Permitter.
3. The Permittee shall retain title to the facility authorized by this permit and all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the construction, maintenance, operation, or repair of said facility shall be borne by the Permittee. Upon the

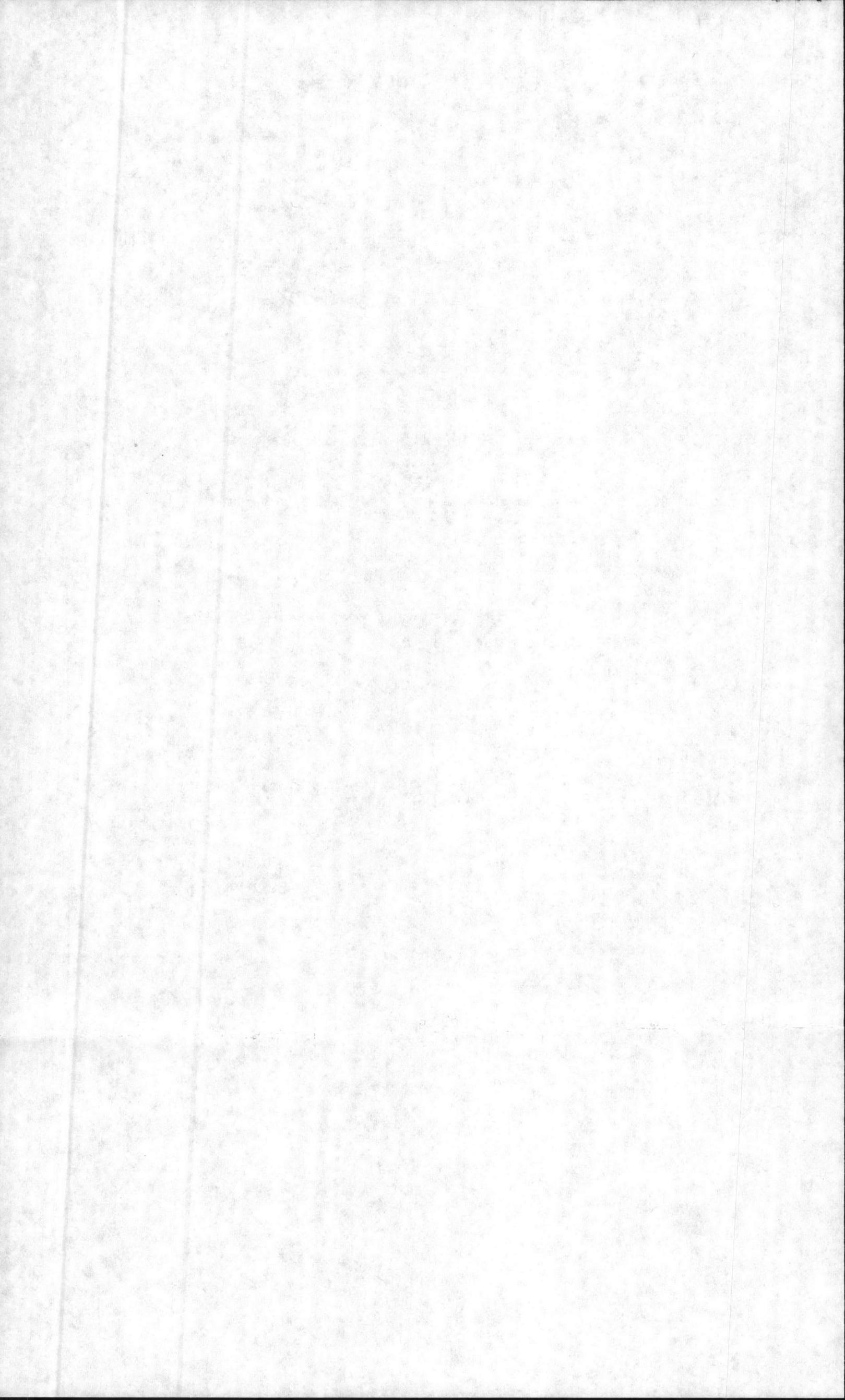


termination of this permit, the Permittee, within a reasonable time thereafter, shall remove the said facility and restore Permitter's land as nearly as practicable to its original condition. Any expense incurred by the Permitter, after such termination, in removing such property, or in restoring said land shall be reimbursed to the Permitter by the Permittee.

4. All activities authorized hereunder shall be subject to such rules and regulations, as regards supervision or otherwise, as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the Permitter, or by the Commanding General, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, who is hereby designated as the local representative of the Navy Department.

5. In the event that death or injury occurs to any person, or loss, destruction or damage occurs to any property of the Permitter, in connection with the construction, maintenance, operation or repair of the facility authorized hereunder, occasioned in whole or in part by the acts or omissions of the Permittee, its agents, employees, or servants, the Permittee agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Permitter from and against any loss, expense, claims or demands to which the Permitter may be subjected as a result of such death, loss, destruction or damage.

6. The Permittee agrees that the names of its employees, whose services will be used in the operation, maintenance, and repair of the facilities located on the land of the Government covered hereunder, will be submitted to the Commanding General, Marine Barracks, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, or his authorized representative, in advance of their actual employment for such purposes, together with pertinent information within the knowledge of the Permittee as to the character, background and international sympathies or affiliations of such employees. The Commanding General or his representative shall approve the



employment of such persons within the confines of the Naval Reservation, as he may deem in the interest of the United States. Only those employees who shall have been approved, as hereinbefore provided, shall be employed for the operation, maintenance, and repair on Government property of the facilities covered hereunder, and those so approved by the Commanding General shall be designated to perform duties for the Permittee within the said Naval Reservation.

7. No Member of or Delegate to Congress or Resident Commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this permit, or to any benefit to arise therefrom. Nothing, however, herein contained shall be construed to extend to any incorporated company, if the permit be for the general benefit of such corporation or company.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Navy Department, on behalf of the United States has caused this permit to be executed, this 26 day of June, 1948.

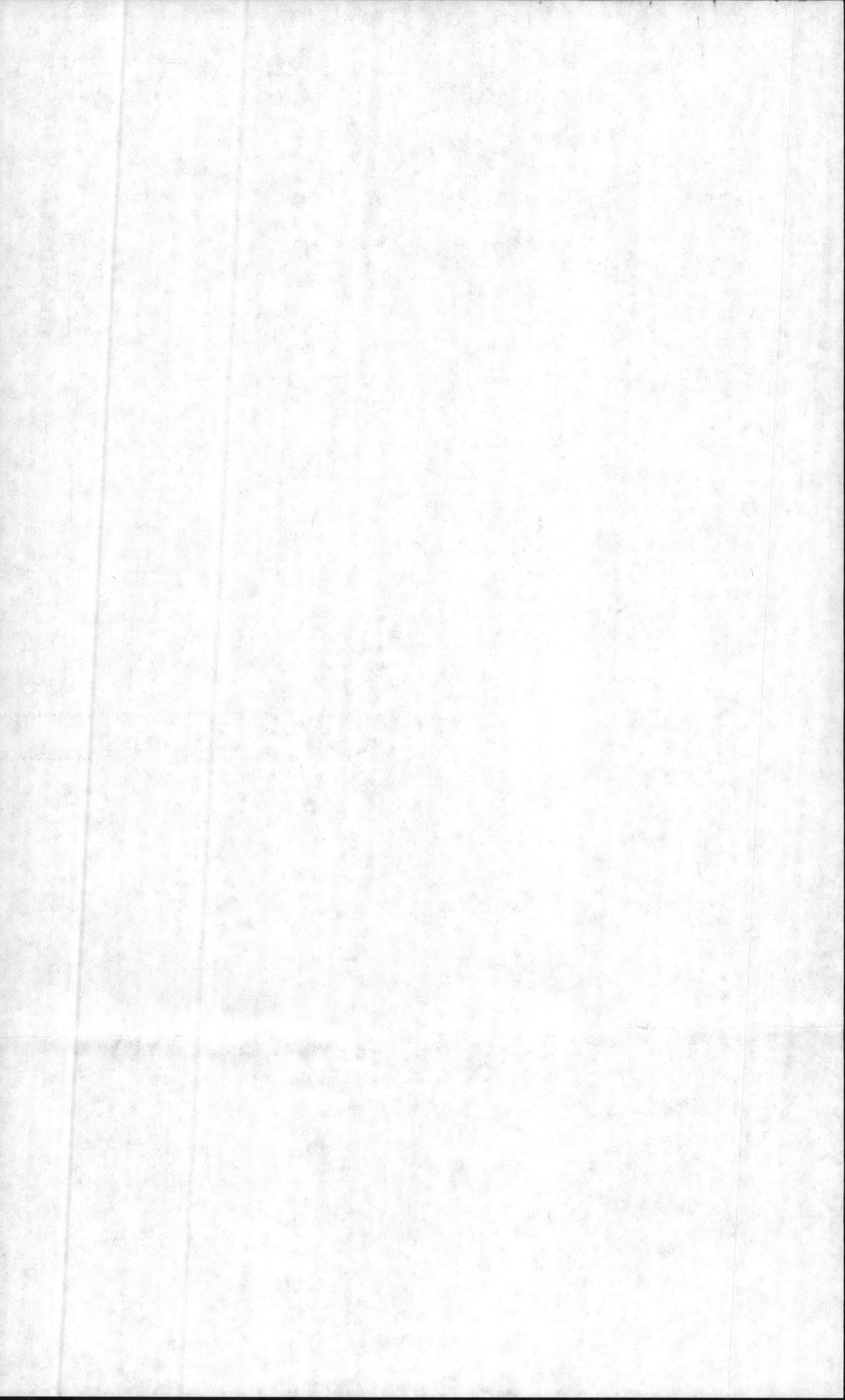

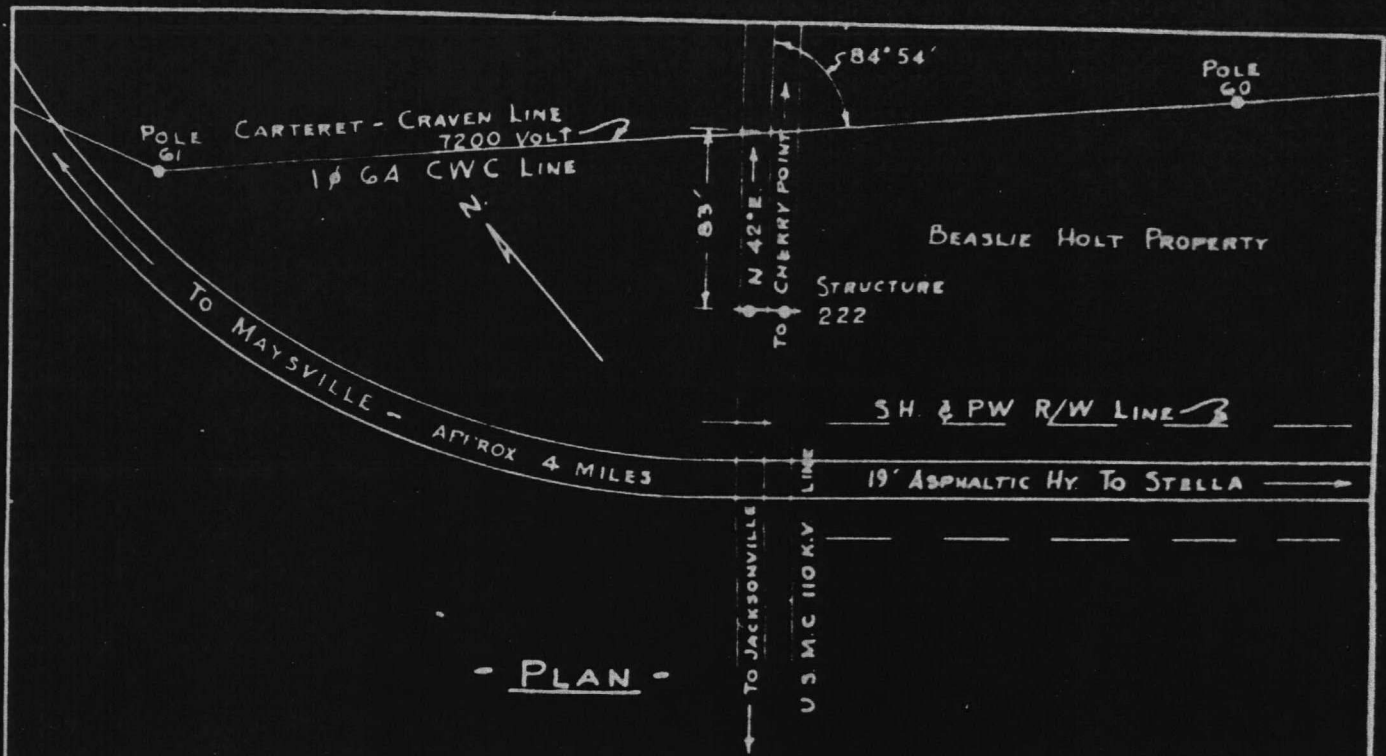

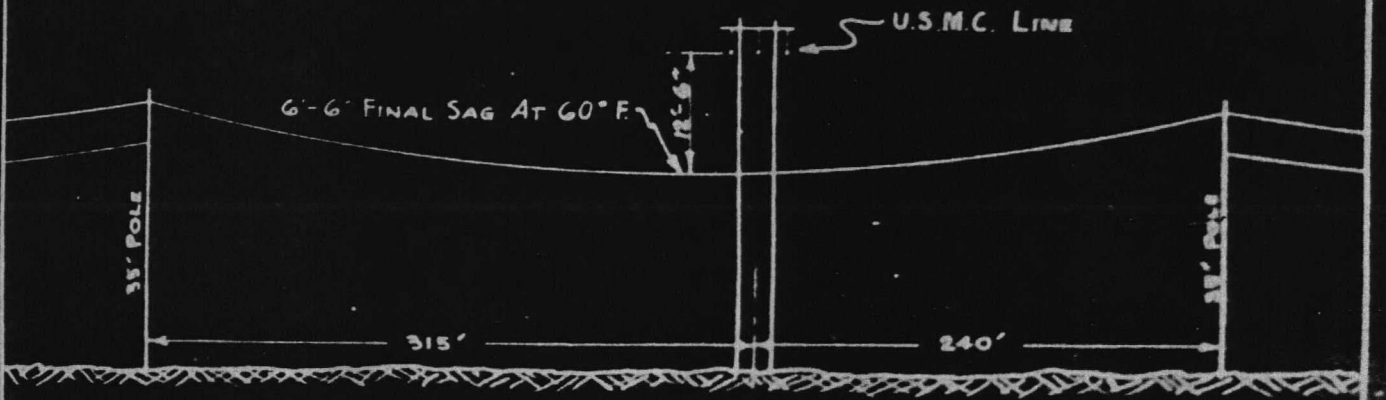
