Attached is a revision of the Camp Lejeune Cooperative Plan for the Conservation of Fish and Wildlife Resources. Provisions in it have been made for controlled public access to Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune for hunting, fishing, trapping and other recreational uses. Such access is granted within manageable quotas, subject to safety, natural resources, environmental, security and military requirements. Opportunities for recreational use of these military lands are equitably distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Permit fees charged to participants in the subject recreational activities are also equitably distributed to all citizens granted access to these military lands. Implementation of equal adjustments for permit fee charges have been reflected in the Cooperative Plan which is enclosed for your review.
