Cooperative Plan Agreement; update of

Reference (a) contained a report of the General Accounting Office visit which involved the feasibility of increasing multiple-use of military land. Reference (b) involved corrective action for compliance of the recommendation contained in reference (a) involving public access. References (c) and (d) requires Marine Corps Base to maintain a Cooperative Plan Agreement with the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission for technical management assistance in support of fish and wildlife resources. The Cooperative Plan Agreement must also include provisions for controlled public access for such recreational uses as hunting, fishing and trapping.

Historically, the fees charged to military and civilian personnel have not been equal to those charged civilian guests. Permit fees for civilian guests were higher than fees for military and civil service personnel. The General Accounting Office (GAO) report shows that the fees for permits should be equal to the public and participation should be on a first-come, first-served basis.

It is recommended that the Cooperative Plan Agreement be signed.
