

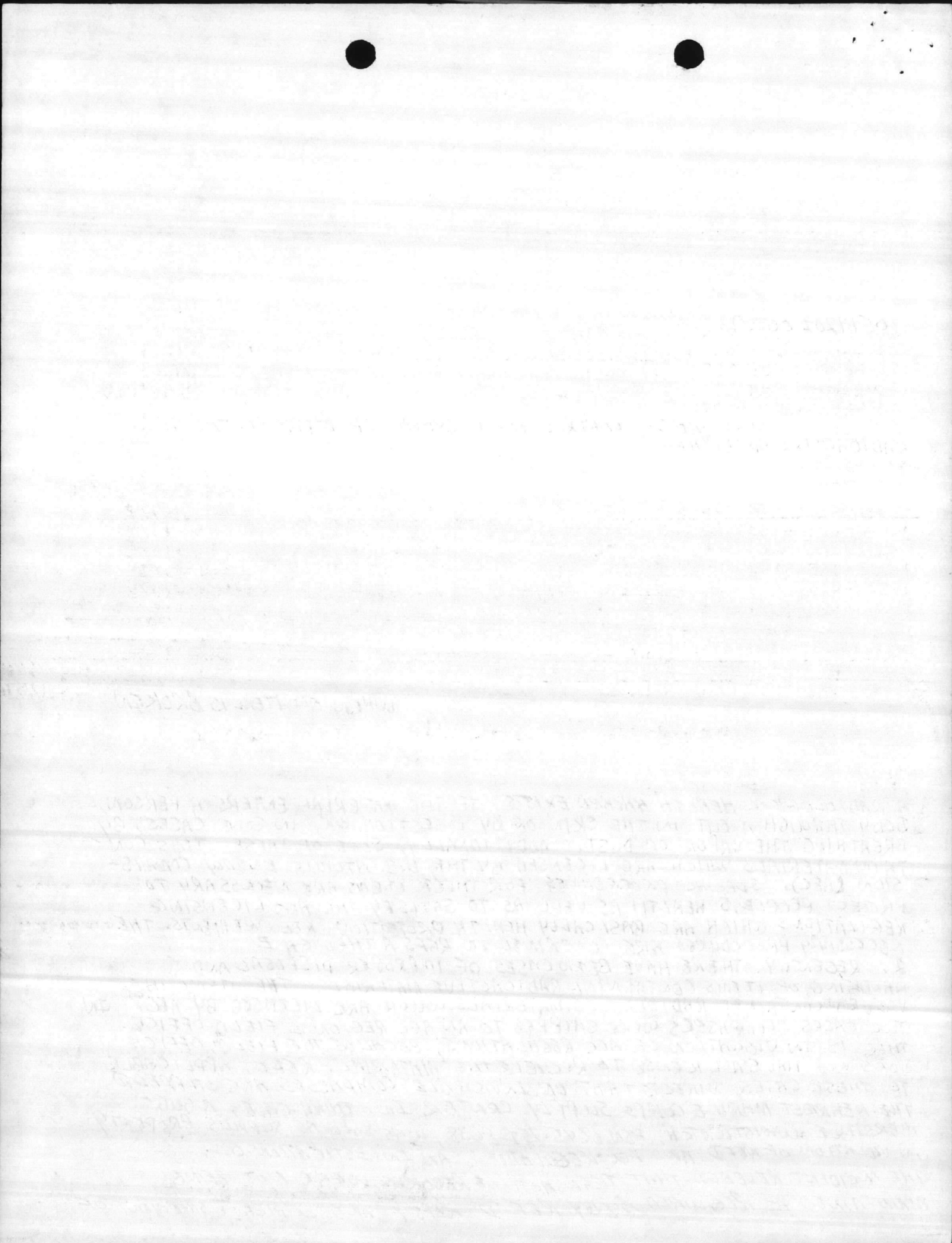

- 10. RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS ARE USED IN MANY COMPASSES, INSTRUMENTS, AND WEAPON SIGHTS TO PROVIDE VISIBILITY AT NIGHT. CERTAIN ELECTRON TUBES ALSO CONTAIN RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS. THESE ITEMS ARE NOT HEALTH HAZARDS UNDER NORMAL USE. HOWEVER, ~~WHEN AN ITEM IS BROKEN~~ BROKEN

~~A RADIOLOGICAL HEALTH HAZARD EXISTS~~ IF THE MATERIAL ENTERS A PERSON'S BODY THROUGH A CUT IN THE SKIN OR BY INGESTION OR, IN SOME CASES, BY BREATHING THE VAPOR OR DUST. ADDITIONALLY, SOME OF THESE ITEMS CONTAIN MATERIALS WHICH ARE LICENSED BY THE U.S. ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION (AEC). ~~SOME~~ PROCEDURES FOR THESE ITEMS ARE NECESSARY TO PROTECT PEOPLE'S HEALTH AS WELL AS TO SATISFY THE AEC LICENSING REGULATIONS WHICH ARE BASICALLY HEALTH PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS. THE ~~NECESSARY PROCEDURES ARE CONTAINED IN REFS A THROUGH E~~

2. RECENTLY, THERE HAVE BEEN CASES OF ~~IMPROPER DISPOSAL AND~~ HANDLING OF ITEMS CONTAINING RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL. THE ITEMS INVOLVED CONTAINED RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS WHICH ARE LICENSED BY AEC. IN TWO CASES, COMPASSES WERE SHIPPED TO AN AEC REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE. THIS IS IN VIOLATION OF AEC REGULATIONS, BECAUSE THE FIELD OFFICE DOES NOT HAVE A LICENSE TO RECEIVE THE MATERIAL. REFC, APPLICABLE TO THESE CASES, ~~DIRECTS THAT UNSERVICABLE COMPASSES ARE SHIPPED TO~~ THE NEAREST MARINE CORPS SUPPLY CENTER. IN A THIRD CASE, A SUBMERSIBLE WRISTWATCH, FSN 6645-752-8638, WAS SOLD AS SURPLUS PROPERTY IN VIOLATION OF REFD AND AEC REGULATIONS, AN INVESTIGATION OF THE INCIDENT REVEALED THAT TRANSACTIONS RECORDS WERE NOT BEING MAINTAINED AS REQUIRED BY REFD REFS F AND OR DIRECT SHIPMENT OF

ALL SUBMERSIBLE WRISTWATCHES, FSN 6645-752-8638, FROM U.S. NAVY MARINE CORPS UNITS STILL HOLD THESE WATCHES, SINCE APPROXIMATELY 75 PERCENT OF THE WATCHES KNOWN TO HAVE ENTERED THE MARINE CORPS INVENTORY CANNOT BE ACCOUNTED FOR FROM TRANSACTION RECORDS PROVIDED IN RESPONSE TO REF H.

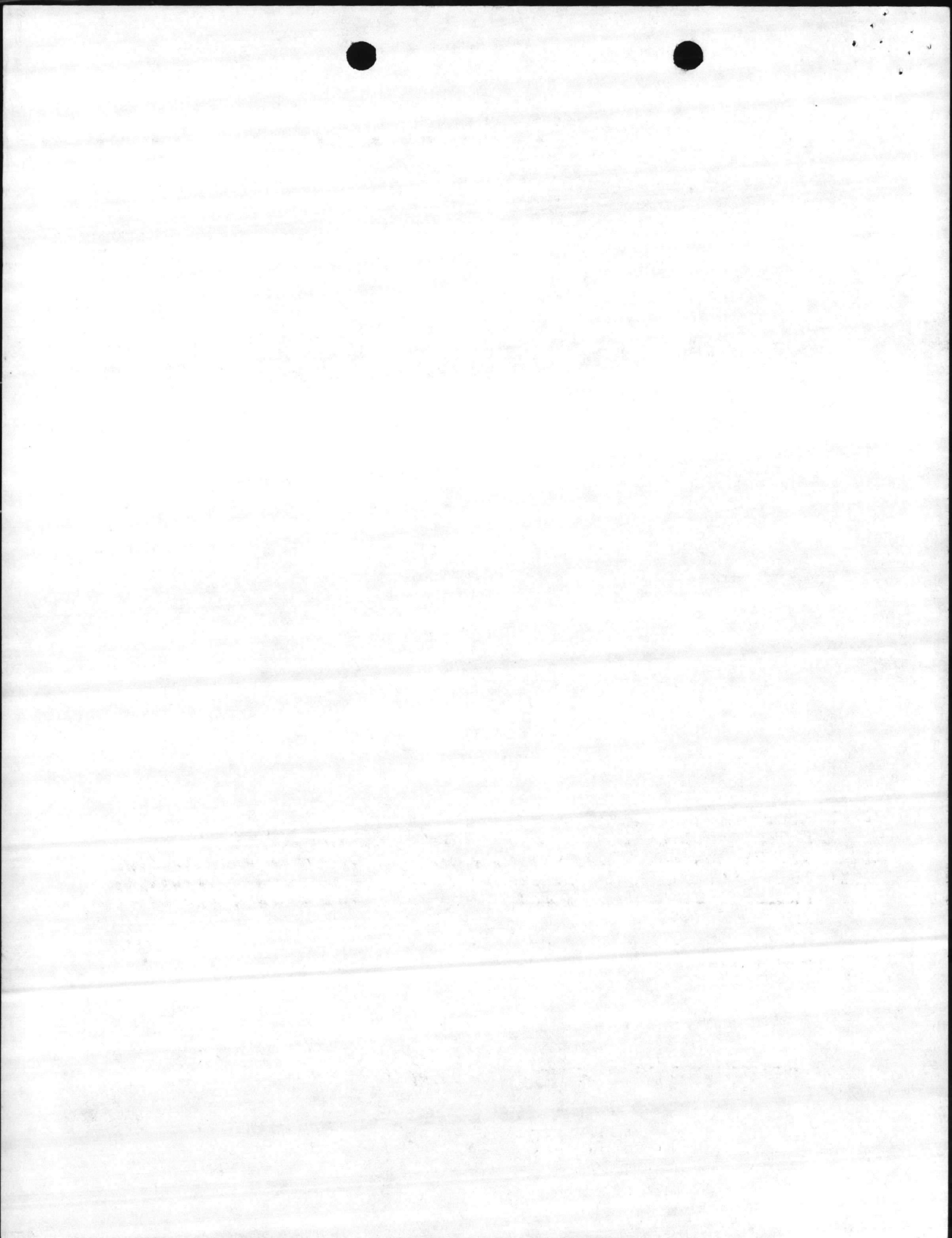

THE BACK OF THE WATCH IS INSCRIBED WITH A RADIATION CAUTION SYMBOL AND THE WORDS "IF FOUND RETURN TO NEAREST MILITARY FACILITY, ABC LICENSE 8-5075-6; DANGER - R/C PG-147, 11/64-RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, NONMAGNETIC - MIL-W-22176, SERIAL...". ALL SUBMERSIBLE WRISTWATCHES FOUND ARE TO BE SHIPPED IN ACCORDANCE WITH R/S F AND G.
