Summary: I believe the concensus is that the solvents were in the
water supply for several years prior to the Holcomb Blvd Water
treatment incident. Some Trihalomethane analysis prior to the incident
was obtained, but the command and Lantdiv did not make the connection.
I recommend you contact Head, EQMB(Betsy) personally for detail and
also a brief HWPCD, Env Planning and Carl Baker if you find the info
to be significant relative to drinking water supply or other
water treatment base operations.

THE AGENCY FOR TOXIC SUBSTANCES AND DISEASE REGISTRY (ATSDR) HAS INQUIRED AS
TO THE FREQUENCY AND TYPE OF LABORATORY ANALYSIS THAT WAS BEING CONDUCTED ON THE
TREATED EFFLUENT LEAVING THE MAIN WATER TREATMENT PLANT AT THE TIME OF THE
DISCOVERY OF TCE IN THE WATER SUPPLY WELL #651 (ALONG OLD PINEY GREEN ROAD) IN
1985.

I TALKED WITH MAC FRAZELLE LAST THURSDAY AND HE INFORMED ME THAT EITHER YOU
OR MR SHARPE WOULD BE LOGGED ON BASE TO KNOW THE FULL STORY ON THE
FREQUENCY AND METHODOLOGY OF THE ANALYTICAL PROCEDURES CONDUCTED AT THAT TIME.
ATSDR IS INTERESTED IN KNOWING WHAT TYPES OF ANALYSES AND AT WHAT FREQUENCY
THOSE ANALYSES WERE PERFORMED ON THE INDIVIDUAL SUPPLY WELLS AS WELL AS THE
TREATED EFFLUENT FROM THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT. THEY ADDITIONALLY ARE
INTERESTED IN HOW WELL #651 WAS DISCOVERED TO BE CONTAMINATED IN THE FIRST
PLACE. WAS THERE AN ESTABLISHED SCHEDULE FOR TESTING SUPPLY WATER WELLS AND
TREATED EFFLUENT FROM THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT OR WAS THIS JUST DONE PERIODICALLY
AS SPOT CHECKS?

IT WOULD SEEM THAT THEIR MAIN CONCERN IS IN THE LEVEL OF TCE CONTAMINATION
AND THAT INDIVIDUALS MIGHT HAVE BEEN EXPOSED TO PRIOR TO WELL #651 BEING TAKEN OUT
OF SERVICE.
