
The Division of Health Assessment and Consultation (DHAC), Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR), has completed its Public Health Assessment of the U.S. Marine Corps Camp Lejeune Military Reservation, dated August 4, 1997. The data and information in the U.S. Marine Corps Camp Lejeune Military Reservation Public Health Assessment have been evaluated, and ATSDR has placed the U.S. Marine Corps Camp Lejeune Military Reservation in the category of no apparent public health hazard.

The Public Health Action Plan (PHAP) contained in the public health assessment describes actions to be taken by ATSDR and/or government agencies designed to identify, mitigate, and prevent adverse human health effects resulting from exposures to hazardous substances in the environment.
