Dear Chris:

We have approved Amendment 62 to the Fishery Management Plan for Groundfish of the Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands Management Area (BSAI FMP), and Amendment 62 to the Fishery Management Plan for Groundfish of the Gulf of Alaska (GOA FMP), and the accompanying final rule. Amendments 62/62 revise the BSAI FMP description of the Catcher Vessel Operational Area and remove the obsolete sunset date for inshore/offshore sector allocations of pollock and Pacific cod in the GOA FMP. The final rule modifies the single geographic location requirement for stationary floating processors (SFPs) authorized under the American Fisheries Act (AFA) by allowing AFA SFPs to relocate up to four times in a year within State of Alaska waters in the BS to process pollock harvested in the BS directed pollock fishery. This action also requires AFA SFPs to process all Gulf of Alaska pollock and Gulf of Alaska Pacific cod where they processed these species in 2002.
