CONCURRENT SPARE PARTS (CSP) CHECKLIST - The CSP Checklist provided with (enter either the TPA Checklist or this LOA) should be completed by the customer or U.S. Army Representative and returned with the accepted copy of the LOA to the U.S. Army Security Assistance Command, Ft. Belvoir, VA. The checklist will be used in developing a CSP listing tailored to the purchaser's specific requirements.

A waiver of CSP Review is included in the CSP Checklist.

CONCURRENT SPARE PARTS (CSP) - The CSP listing(s) for line(s) \_\_\_\_\_ will be developed upon LOA acceptance and receipt of the CSP Checklist. A preliminary cost estimate has been used and is subject to adjustment once the final listing has been developed. The final listing will be provided within 60 days after case implementation for customer review. Within 60 days, the marked up listing should be returned to the U.S. Army Security Assistance Command, New Cumberland, PA. Requisitions for CSP items will be issued upon the receipt of the marked up list from customer or receipt of a signed waiver from the customer.

### CONCURRENT SPARE PARTS (CSP)

The CSP listing(s) for line(s) \_\_\_\_\_ is/are provided with this LOA. The purchaser should review and annotate items needed to fulfill his support requirements. The LOA will be returned to the U.S. Army Security Assistance Command, 5701 21st Street, Building 216, Ft. Belvoir, VA 22060. The CSP listing(s) will be returned to the U.S. Army Security Assistance Command, 54 "M" Avenue, Suite 1, New Cumberland, PA 17070. The listing(s) will be validated and the LOA modified, if necessary. (C12.C)

## CONCURRENT SPARE PARTS (CSP)

CSPs are shipped as they become available, with the final shipment anticipated no later than the lead time indicated. Parts may be furnished from either new, unused or overhauled stocks and they may be intermingled. All parts will meet U.S. troop standards of serviceability. The U.S. Army will use its' best efforts to ensure that 100 percent of the critical items CSP support is made available prior to release of the end item. If this is not possible, a waiver for release of the supported end item may be required. It should be recognized that failure to purchase CSPs offered may result in poor maintenance and unacceptable failure rates of the end items they support. (C12.A1).

Lead Time for Repair Parts -- Due to the capability to supply the major defense equipment in the short lead time quoted, some ancillary/support equipment and/or required repair parts can/will arrive in-country after delivery of the end item. (L3)
