SUBJECT: Meritorious Unit Commendation (2009-10) [4th Battalion, 319th Field Artillery Regiment]

1. Reference U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) Permanent Order 019-10, dated 19 January 2011 [received 1 February 2011].
2. The U.S. Army Center of Military History (CMH) has received information provided by the HRC regarding the unit(s) intended for recognition in this decoration for the period **21 November 2009 to 6 November 2010**. Based on HRC's authorizations, and whenever feasible, CMH is providing official designations for recognized unit(s); and, per its responsibilities under ARs 600-8-22 and 840-10, verifying entitlement to an appropriately inscribed decoration streamer as indicated below. Also indicated is the correct streamer size (if authorized), and authorization for a streamer to be issued with an earned-honor device (i.e., a laurel wreath) which applies only to certain combat arms units. In those cases where the unit designation provided by HRC cannot be verified as belonging to any unit currently listed on the official rolls of the Army (which are maintained by CMH under ARs 870-5 and 220-5), no further action will be taken by CMH and no streamer will be authorized at this time (see final paragraph). The same is true if official authorization for an organizational flag or guidon is unknown. If appropriate, the table below also indicates any unit entitled to a decoration streamer, but which is currently inactive and unavailable to receive a streamer.

SUBJECT: Meritorious Unit Commendation (2009-10) [4th Battalion, 319th Field Artillery Regiment]

3. As indicated above, TACOM is authorized to provide appropriately embroidered decoration streamer(s) to HRC's Awards and Decorations Branch who will make distribution to each authorized unit. Streamer authorization is based solely upon unit recognition information provided by HRC. Therefore, issuance of a streamer at this time does not necessarily confer permanent unit entitlement. Final determination regarding entitlement to display the streamer remains with CMH who will determine each unit's lineage and honors (for MTOE organizations). As with similar War on Terrorism decorations, organic guidon-bearing elements recognized with their battalion (or squadron) headquarters are not authorized to display the honor separately from the battalion's colors. Recognizing the operational conventions of the Army Modular Force designs, however, comparable unit awards earned *separately* by a battalion's organic companies will not pass to the parent battalion's colors or duplicate its honors. In addition, any approved or pending award independently earned by another of the battalion's organic guidon-bearing elements will not be considered a duplication of a battalion (or company) honor and may be displayed on the appropriate company guidon. Where appropriate, these cases are indicated by including months in the streamer inscriptions for the organic guidon-bearing element which has been recognized separately from its parent organization. Furthermore, because there have been significant problems with much of the source material (particularly period of service dates), this memorandum should not be used to officially confirm whether or not a unit participated in any particular action or deployment. Period of service dates have been provided by HRC, and CMH assumes that any recognized dates not reflecting "periods of service pre-dating the submission of the award nomination" or recognition duplicating other unit awards were approved as an exception to policy. Deployment and mobilization dates (correct or otherwise) which may conflict with regulatory guidance for this decoration will also be considered as an exception to policy. HRC, however, may later alter the recognized period of service dates to meet regulatory criteria. 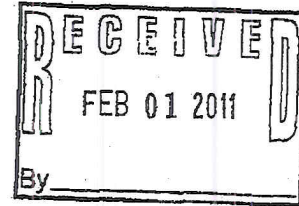
