

NCOES INSTRUCTOR PREREQUISITES

The Noncommissioned Officer Academy is always looking for professional Noncommissioned Officers in the rank of SSG-SFC to be Small Group Leaders and Senior Small Group Leaders. Below are the prerequisites for being a WLC Instructor:

- High School Graduate or GED equivalent.
- Have no personal habits or character traits that are questionable from a security standpoint.
- Possess mature judgment and initiative.
- Have at least 3 years Time in Service (TIS) remaining or be able to reenlist or extend to meet the requirement.
- Display good military bearing.
- Meet body composition requirements IAW AR 600-9.
- Be able to pass the Army Physical Fitness Test.
- Possess no permanent or temporary profiles that interfere with the performance of duties as an Instructor.
- Have recently held a leadership assignment.
- Have no speech impediments.
- Have no record of conviction by Special or General Court Martial.
- Possess no negative evaluations or Reliefs for Cause.
- Must not be required to register as a sexual offender IAW AR 27-10.
- SGLs must hold the rank of SSG or SGT (P) with prior assignment experience in a Skill Level 3 leadership position as evidenced by an NCOER.
- If certified, NCOs can continue SGL instructor duties for up to two years after promotion to SFC.
- Complete leader heat and cold injury prevention training semiannually (conducted at the Academy).
- Senior Small Group Leaders (SFC) must meet the above listed and possess Skill Level 4 leadership experience.
