### **Equipment Requesting Directive & Forms**

In an effort to encourage outreach to our youngest military family members, the California National Guard State Child & Youth Program has placed a variety of equipment in identified locations throughout the state. The find a list of these location please visit the Child and Youth Program website at <a href="http://www.calguard.ca.gov/readyfamilies/Pages/child\_youth.aspx">http://www.calguard.ca.gov/readyfamilies/Pages/child\_youth.aspx</a> These items will be hand receipted out to a Military Point of Contact (MPOC) in support of efforts specifically geared to the support of CNG children and youth. The requesting process is as follows:

### **Check Out Process:**

- > Complete a CNGCYP Equipment request forms listed below and submit it to the FAN closest to you housing the equipment.
- Coordinate a pick up time for the equipment with FAN.
- You will sign out the equipment and be given a copy of your sign out sheet.
- When returning the equipment back to the FAN, the FAN will inventory all equipment making sure the equipment is all there and in good working order.
- Also when return equipment please return the Evaluation form at the end of this packet. This evaluation helps the Child and Youth Program track the benefit of this equipment.
- If there are any issues with your evaluation or any issues with the equipment itself you will receive a follow up call from the Child and Youth Program.
- If you have any questions regarding any of the items on the sign out sheet, such as direction on putting equipment together, or suggestions on activities to do with the Team building kits, please contact Child and Youth Outreach Assistant in your area.

#### Additional Information:

- ➤ Because of the high dollar value on the items listed under <u>Pinnacle kits</u> or <u>Electronics</u> section listed below you will need to have an MPOC sign for these items.
- If at any time, equipment is damaged or lost due to poor supervision or neglect, the unit or command group will forfeit the ability to request equipment for future activities.

Note: All activities need to be conducted or supervised by a CNG livescanned adult (livescans through any other agency do not meet regulatory requirements) IF THE PARENTS **ARE NOT** GOING TO BE SUPERVISING THE CHILD. It is encouraged that each unit appoint a volunteer youth advisor as part of their FRG with the requirement that they attend CNGCYP youth training to ensure they are familiar with all child related resources, materials & program objectives
