The purposes of the visit were to discuss the nuclear safety oversight strategy, initiate the site lead program, increase operational awareness of the site's activities, and discuss methods the Office of Health, Safety and Security (HSS) uses to carry out its independent oversight responsibilities.

The Y-12 Site Office (YSO) staff and facility representatives provided HSS personnel with detailed tours of several site facilities including Building 9212 and the Highly Enriched Uranium Materials Facility. The tours gave HSS personnel the opportunity to interact with YSO staff and become knowledgeable of the current status of each facility.

During the visit, HSS personnel briefed the Deputy Site Manager and members of the YSO senior staff on HSS's new approach to oversight of safety. HSS personnel also attended a briefing on the Uranium Processing Facility design and project status.

Result:

The purposes of the orientation visit were accomplished. The site lead met key personnel and obtained an operational awareness of the facilities.
